Pardons Board Selection Out Baldwin Failed to Conform to Law in Picking His Appointee.

State Capitol, Hartford, May 3.—Gov. Baldwin broke a custom of about 18 years and failed to conform with the statute in appointing a Republican to replace a Democrat on the State Board of Pardons. It was learned today.

Last week, the governor went to the Senate for approval of the name of Warren P. Cressy of Stamford, former president of the Connecticut State Bar Association, to succeed Richard J. Smith of Westport, a Democrat, whose second four-year term ends June 7. The nomination was made Tuesday.

The governor, apparently, failed to notice that Section 197 of the General Statutes provides that no more than two of the four lay members of the board may be members of the same political party.

It appeared today that the governor was to give a recess appointment to another Democrat for the vacant position.
