### No Potatoes in Hartford

Have Disappeared from Nearly All Restaurants, Factory Cafeterias.

Hartford, May 5.—Potatoes have virtually disappeared from nearly all restaurants, factory cafeterias and other places where they are normally served. The public does not like it.

Most eating places today are offering potato substitutes—rice, macaroni, spaghetti and hotchkiss.

Elmer A. White, president of the Hartford Restaurant Association, said that many restaurants have been without potatoes for a year or more.

He said that he had stocked up before the shortage, but serving potatoes is no longer profitable. He said that he had only a few small potatoes left, which he had sold at 90 percent.

Retail stores and wholesalers have been unable to get practically anything but seed potatoes in recent weeks. This, he said, has disappeared from the market and no relief can be expected for several weeks.

With the drop in supplies comes a rise in prices. The price of a bushel of potatoes has risen to 45 cents, he said.

A chief revealed that he had had telephone calls from people in other parts of the state, who were saying that potatoes in the south are in a serious shortage.
