Reds Penetrate Outer Defenses Of Novorossisk

Soviet Advance in Kuban Coincides With Continued Fierce Air Fighting; 930 German Planes Reported Destroyed Last Week.

Moscow, May 10.—(AP)—Red Army forces have penetrated the outer fortifications of Novorossisk, dislodging the Germans from the front declared today, and are persistently crumbling the enemy defenses and breaking into the depths of the position.

London, May 10.—(AP)—Powerful 400-motor American P-47 Thunderbolt fighters were dispatched today to have gone into action in the European theater of operations.

Squadrons of these fighters were ordered to the Eighth Air Force fighter command and have been making intermittent sweeps over the continent and constituting a major portion of the escort which helped the Flying Fortresses May 10 in the attack on Berlin.

Exceptionally powerful, the heavy bombers were escorted by P-47s. The fighters scored at high altitudes, less than 30,000 feet, in the vicinity of the city.
