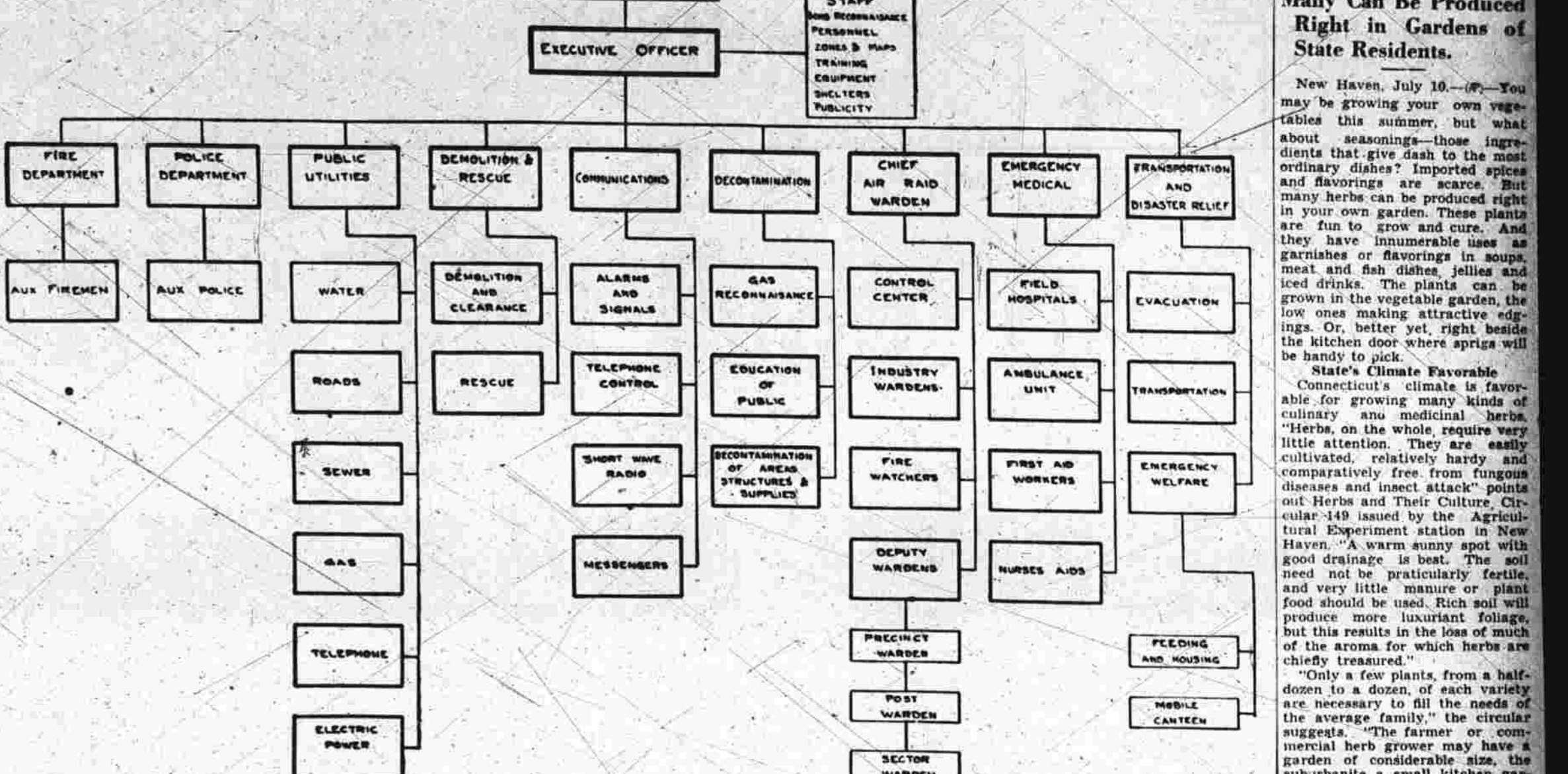

Bomber Raid May Use Huge Amount of Gas

Million Gallons Likely To Be Consumed in One Raid; East and Gulf Coasts Supply.

Washington, July 10.—A thousand bombers raiding Europe may use a million gallons of 100-octane gasoline. A tanker's average load is less than three million gallons (60,000 barrels). Consider the slowness of the tankers, the length of their journey—and those two statements from the Army Air Force will give you some idea of the difficulty of supplying the tremendous bombing operations of the United States.

That million-gallons-per-raid figure is just a fixed-up example to put the problem in understandable terms. Probably more often than not, it wouldn't be so accurate. Actually, all raids are likely to differ in the amount of gas they burn. Distance, wind, speed, and the types of planes involved are all factors which affect the amount of gasoline consumed.

The Army doesn't talk much on such topics. There are too many security angles, so which the lives of pilots, the fate of planes and the whole mission of the raid, might depend. Even the total consumption of 100-octane gasoline—the stuff that makes planes take off, fly faster, climb more steeply, hit a higher ceiling, and range farther—is a secret, but you begin to sense the picture when you think of these planes in one area, and relate them to the various theaters of operation around the globe.

Practically all this high-octane gasoline comes from the United States. Even the North African theater, relatively close to the "East" oil fields (which, incidentally, are said to be producing satisfactorily) uses mostly gasoline shipped from this country.

In the words of Robert Patterson, undersecretary of war, an operational reserve must be built up in each theater to meet any unforeseeable contingencies.

Most Accumulated Stocks This means that immense stocks must be accumulated here to meet the demands of the war.

To supply the demands of high octane consumption and that of ordinary gasoline, the Maritime Commission says it has built seven 125,000-barrel tankers and is building 200 more, in addition to smaller lend-lease tankers which are used by our allies for coastal distribution overseas.

For the European theater, this gasoline leaves from the east and Gulf coasts, and to get it there the government has pressed into service some of the facilities normally used for getting gasoline to east coast civilian supplies.

Cuts in Civilian Supplies To this extent, supplying our air force with high octane gasoline has cut into civilian supplies because it utilized transportation.

Other than that, there is no conflict, says the Army, because automobiles and trucks do not use high-octane gasoline.
