Nazis Claim 11 Allied Ships Sent to Bottom
London, July 28.—(AP)—The German high command asserted in its communique today that 11 Allied ships and boats had been sunk and 11 others, including a light cruiser, had been damaged in various air and sea actions. The claims, broadcast from Berlin and recorded by The Associated Press, were without Allied confirmation. The actions were listed as follows:
U-boat sank eight ships totaling 4,241 tons and damaged six freighters and a light cruiser in the Atlantic and Mediterranean. Long-distance bombers sank two merchantmen and damaged three in the Atlantic. Other German broadcasts said this action was off the coast of the Azores.
German patrol boats engaged British torpedo boats off the coast of the Azores. The British coast and sank one and damaged one.
