**German Defences Close to Kharkov Crumbling Today**  
 (Continued from Page One)  
 Gains also were reported west and southwest of Kharkov between Orel and Karachev. Soviet guards stormed into Dmitrovsk-Olovskoy, which the Germans had transformed into a strongly fortified base, and smashed enemy resistance after fierce street fighting. More than 2,000 German officers and men were slain in this engagement, while the Russians captured 12 tanks, 16 guns, 200 machine-guns and 200 mortars, 200 trucks and 200 automobiles.  
 On the Kharkov salient the Germans were reported using fresh forces rushed from Germany in an attempt to stem the Russian tide. In Montgomery, commander of British and engineering detachments into the front lines.  
 The Kharkov escape corridor has been narrowed from 60 to 37 miles during the past 48 hours, and as the struggle for the city entered its ninth day, advances from two sides indicated the Nazis would fight to the finish, rather than attempt a strategic retreat.  
 The British command in northern and southern Europe may be found in the North African operations. The British on the east and the Americans on the west battled the Germans with coordinated but independent blows Eisenhower's hands.  
 Position grows out of shift in the British command in India last spring. At that time Gen. Auchinleck succeeded to command-in-chief.
