### Grand List Increased By Over Three Million

Assessors' Report to Selectmen Points to Great Boost in Residences, Inventories.

Assessors Emil G. Hohenbach, Thomas J. Lewis and Henry A. Kirtland, in submitting the report of their year's work to the Board of Selectmen, point to the large increase in the assessment of dwellings and inventories in the year. Dwellings on the grand list of 1947 increased \$2,167,808 over the list of 1946. Inventories, due to the considerably higher stocks of merchandise and goods in local stores, increased \$1,042,518 over 1947. The grand list increase was \$3,210,326, or 3.3 per cent.

**Highest in 20 Years**

Submitted with the report are four charts showing the trend of the present time. This year's grand list of \$44,615,236 was the highest for a period of 20 years. The list of 1921 going over \$54,000,000 to win all high honors for the grand list in Manchester.

This chart shows a low point in 1925 when the grand list was just a little over \$35,000,000. The report states this was due to revaluation which resulted in much lower assessments on property. From 1925 to 1939 there was little construction in the grand list. Then in early 1940 the list is shown on the chart as starting upward, increasing sharply in 1941 and 1942. The 1947 grand list figure mentioned above.

**Fluctuation in Values**

The second chart in the report illustrates the fluctuation in valuation of two items, inventories and dwellings. The report says that it is interesting to note that since inventories are corrected yearly, the change has taken place in the past 10 years.

**Rise, Fall of Tax Rate**

The third chart shows the rise and fall of the tax rate for the past decade. It is pointed out that the average taxpayer's income had been materially reduced in 1935, making it doubly difficult for him to meet his tax bill.

**Other Details of Report**

The report concludes: "During the past year the Assessors have added a new classification to their records. Real estate has previously either taxable, or in certain specific instances, as for example, church, town or state owned employed, exempt by statute.

**Governmental Projects**

The two new Federal Housing projects situated in the western part of the town were approved under an act of the Congress, which stipulates that in lieu of taxes paid through the regular channel, the Federal Public Housing Authority shall pay direct to the town a lump sum of money, which shall be approximately in amount to the sum the property would otherwise be taxed for if privately owned.

"After a careful analysis of the costs of these two housing projects, values deemed to be equitable and fair were determined by the Assessors. These values were duly examined in detail by the Federal appraisers, and were fully acceptable to them. Incidentally, in some other municipalities the Federal authorities refused to accept the values and insisted on using their own valuation. In due course the Manchester Town Treasurer received the tax payment in full, based on the Assessors' figures and the current tax rate, from the Federal Government.

"An unusual item confronting the Assessors this past year was the adjustment of values on farming land effected by condemnation proceedings. The State of Connecticut recently purchased a strip of land for a new state highway. This right of way, encompassing at the East Hartford line, extends diagonally across the northern part of Manchester to the Vernon town line. The acquisition of this land left many irregular shaped parcels. This not only necessitated deductions for the amount of acreage taken, but as farms land is valued into several classes bearing different values in accordance with their utility, it involved ascertaining the exact amount of acreage in each class in arriving at the correct adjustment.
