Senator Gillette Declares Time Is Past Due for Post-War Proposals

Washington, Sept. 14.—(AP)—Asserting that the United States is not doing enough to bring about a settlement of the post-war situation, Senator Gillette (D., Iowa), called today for immediate action of a resolution committing the United States to a post-war coalition on keeping the peace.

While he thought the resolution should be thought in general terms to eliminate "contention and delay," Gillette said the other Allies should have assurance of our willingness to cooperate.

Gillette is a member of a Senate Foreign Relations subcommittee which already has received reports from the Senate on the subject of the post-war situation, including the much-discussed Burton-Hatch bill.

Demand Cooperation Gillette expressed belief that "the American people are entitled to know the American people's role in the post-war situation."

Senator Hill (D., Ala.), one of the sponsors, agreed with Gillette that action should be taken "without further delay."

At the same time, Hill said he would agree to the setting up of machinery for setting disputes and to "whatever such action."
