By these state papers, it is clear that we never intended to give our assistance to the Vichy government, made any secret of our sympathies and purposes in this matter before we were informed by the French government that it was in a position to do so.

By the recognition of Vichy, we also, however, helped sustain Petain in what authority and prestige he did have in the eyes of the French people.

Assuming that we did have influence on Vichy, and that our policy can actually be given some credit for the fact that the French fleet did not become part of Germany's war equipment, the final audit also might ask whether our diplomacy was as shrewd and practical and far-seeing as it now seems to establish.

In the light of after-developments, at least, it seems obvious that the disposition of the French fleet, one way or another, was of considerably less importance to us than the disposition of just one section of that over-seas empire was promised to restore France in return for good conduct in the matter of the fleet.
