Brown Stamps
Brown Stamp F in Book Three becomes valid with stamps C, D and E through October 30.

Blue Stamps
Stamps U, V, and W valid to October 20. Stamps X, Y, and Z valid to November 20.

Sugar
Stamp No. 14 valid to November 1. No. 15 and 16 each good for five pounds for home canning only, expire October 31.

Shoes
Stamp No. 18 War Ration Book One extended for one pair for an indefinite period after October 31. Loose coupons are not valid except with a mail order.

Fuel Oil
Period 1 coupons of 1943-44 season now valid to January 4, 1944. Class 4 coupons worth 10 gallons, class 5 coupons worth 50 gallons.

Stoves
Heating or cooking stoves using coal, wood, gas or oil are now rationed. Apply to local ration board for a purchase certificate.

The Inspection
Accurately deadline March 11, October 31 and C November 30.

Gasoline
Number 6 stamps in A Books good for three gallons each through November 8 and C coupons are good for two gallons each.

Printing and selling stamps
The sale of stamps is prohibited. Refuse such traffic and report it to the nearest OPA office.

Rationing News

By the first of November, all of us are going to have another ration book. The War Ration Book Four. It won't be delivered to us by mail in the case of War Ration Book Three. Instead, we will register for and receive it at our neighborhood schoolhouse between October 20 and October 30.

Our Connecticut school teachers who did such a splendid job in issuing the first two ration books, at a sacrifice of their spare time and for no pay, have agreed to handle the issuance of the new book. And judging from past performances, we know the operation will run smoothly.

I advise all of you to watch your local newspaper closely for the next week for announcement of the specific time and place of the registration in your community.

Here are a few things you should know about this fourth ration book:

First, it will almost immediately replace the one you are presently using in Book Two, and eventually it will take the place of Book One in the rationing of sugar and alcohol.

When you get the new book, you will notice it contains stamps marked "Coffee." Best assured that these stamps are not for your Government plans to put coffee back on the ration list. But the new books were printed early in July, before coffee supplies grew so plentiful that there was no need of rationing it. It would have cost hundreds of thousands of dollars to reprint the book, and so it comes to you with the coffee stamps.

Another thing that you'll notice is that the stamps in Book Four are only about half the size of those you have grown accustomed to. While this fact may make you wince, it has its compensations. Namely, that the new book will last you for a good long time and thereby will save us taxpayers a big sum of money in printing costs and it's much less bulky than a book with larger stamps would have been.

There's a little detail connected with your gasoline ration coupons that is going to be of growing importance to your service station operator from now on. As most of you know, all of these coupons must be endorsed in ink on the face with the registration number of your car and the name of the State before it can be legally "spent" for gasoline.

Some gasoline stations have been falling to insist upon this endorsement. As a result, a number of counterfeit coupons have strayed into ration banking accounts and our Enforcement Division is now making a star-wide investigation of all stations, particularly those which have accepted counterfeit stamps. The presence of counterfeit stamps in any gasoline station is proof that the dealer is accepting loose coupons and this in itself is against the law.

Every car owner can make the job of gasoline station operators easier by endorsing his gasoline coupons properly today. It's the work of only a few minutes and it can mean the saving of hundreds of barrels of gasoline from the Black Market. Be sure to endorse the coupons in your new "A" book as soon as you receive it.

On the same subject—... and that means every passenger car owner in Connecticut... should have his application for the new "A" gasoline book in the hands of his Local War Price and Rationing Board not later than October 21. If you miss this deadline, you may still file the application, but you won't receive the new book until after November 8, the day Stamp A-8 becomes effective.

Reminder to "B" gasoline ration users: The deadline for your current tire inspection is October 31. Without an up-to-date tire inspection record, you won't be able to get the new "A" ration book. Better make a date with your neighborhood tire inspector without delay.
