Japan's Navy Unable to Get Closer Than 40 Miles to Marine Beach-head on Bougainville; American Warships All Remain Afloat.

Southwest Pacific Allied Headquarters, Nov. 5.—(AP)—Japan's Navy, lured more and more within range of American ships, guns, and bombers, by threatened loss of the Solomons, already has paid the price of 14 warships sunk or damaged this week without getting closer than 40 miles to the U. S. Marine beach-head on Bougainville.

Sunk in Bomb Blitz Forty miles east of United States fighting ships shattered that night by a heavy bomber attack. The attack was the first since the Japanese navy's retreat from Rabaul through darkness and blinding rain early Tuesday and about the Marines at Empress Augusta bay.

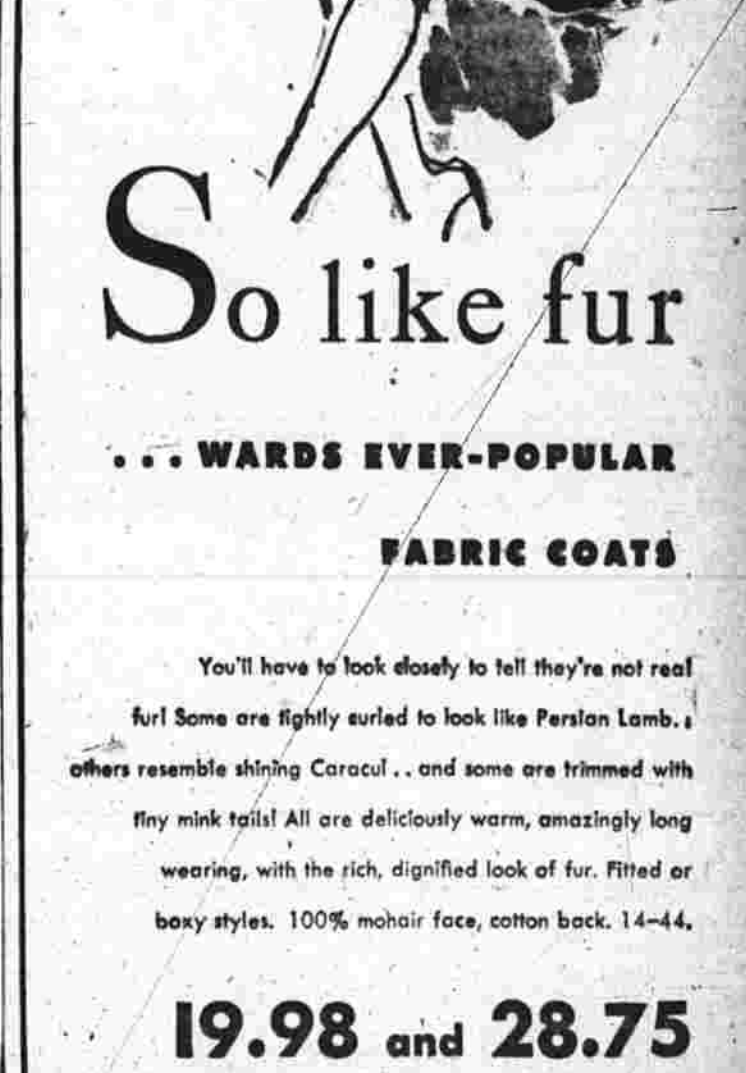
