American Marines Expand Offensive; Land on 3rd Atoll

Patton Defenders Continue Fierce Defense While Falling Back on Beaches of Other Two Islands; Powerful Supporting Naval Units Remaining in Sector; Battle Seen Bloody. Pearl Harbor, Nov. 23.—(AP)—United States Marines have swiftly expanded the four-day-old offensive in the equatorial Gilberts by landing on a third atoll even as Japanese defenders continued to put up a fierce fight while falling back from the beaches on the other two. The fact that the new amphibious operation on Abemama atoll was announced Saturday's initial landing on Makin and Tarawa indicated powerful supporting naval units remained in the Japanese area to reinforce their operations.

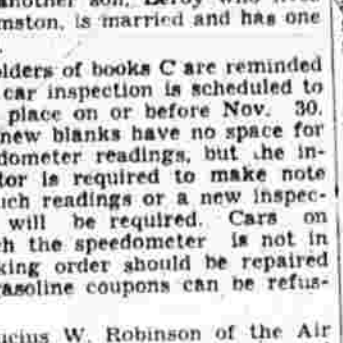

Tons of Destruction Are Hurlled Down on German Capital; Correspondents of Swedish Newspapers Say New Fires and Walls of Flames Sweep City After Second Attack.

London, Nov. 24.—(AP)—The R.A.F. hurled tons of destruction down on Berlin again last night, seeking for the second night in succession to knock out the German capital much of it already devastated. The force and weight of bombs dropped last night probably approached that of the record of Monday night when over 2,500 long tons were delivered by approximately 1,000 bombers, nearly all of them four-engine giants.

Only 20 Planes Lost
Despite more favorable weather for the defense, the R.A.F. lost only 20 planes in the second successive Berlin attack and simultaneous Moscow attacks on the western German coast, compared to 26 lost in comparable operations the night before.
