Reds Roll Westward Steadily in 6 Areas; Converge on Zhlobin

Doggily Batter Through Swamps, Forests and Plains Densely Spotted With Heavily Fortified German Defense Works; Reported Progress Reported in Zhlobin Sector.

Moscow, Nov. 30.—(AP)—Russian Armies rolled steadily westward on six sectors of the front today—three in White Russia and three in the Ukraine—doggedly battering their way through forests, swamps and plains densely spotted with heavily fortified German defense works.

Reels Capture Stragglers A Russian communiqué said that Red Army spearheads had captured 25 miles northwest of Zhlobin on the Gomel-Minsk railway.

Eight hundred Germans were reported killed as the Russians surged forward in this area, about 100 miles from the city.

Lauchlin Currie, U. S. ambassador to the Soviet Union, said that the Red Army was making steady progress in the Ukraine.

Yanks Bury Pal in Italian Valley

Italian, Nov. 30.—(AP)—U. S. Eighth Air Force heavy bombers attacked targets in western Germany in daylight today, setting a record of 11 major raids for one month's heavy operations from bases in Britain.

Following on the heels of last night's R. A. F. Mosquito bomber raid on the same general area, the American heavies were supported by U. S. B-24 Liberator and Allied fighters during their mission.

Seasoned Aussies Nearer to Bonga; Wewak Attacked

Southwest Pacific Allied Headquarters, Nov. 30.—(AP)—Seasoned Australian troops on Bonga, another Japanese outpost in the New Guinea jungle, Tanks crunched through the tangled undergrowth in support of the troops as the attack started, while B-24 Liberator bombers attacked the treetops slanting enemy positions with machine-guns.

Wewak Attacked A strong force of Liberators dumped tons of bombs on Wewak, Japanese stronghold on the northeast coast of New Guinea. There was no interception.

Seen Offset To Big News Nazis Launch Propaganda Offensive With Talk of Peace Bids.

Washington, Nov. 30.—(AP)—Talk of German peace overtures was viewed here today as a sign that Nazi leaders have launched a propaganda offensive to counter the expected big news from a conference of President Roosevelt, Prime Minister Churchill and Marshal Stalin.

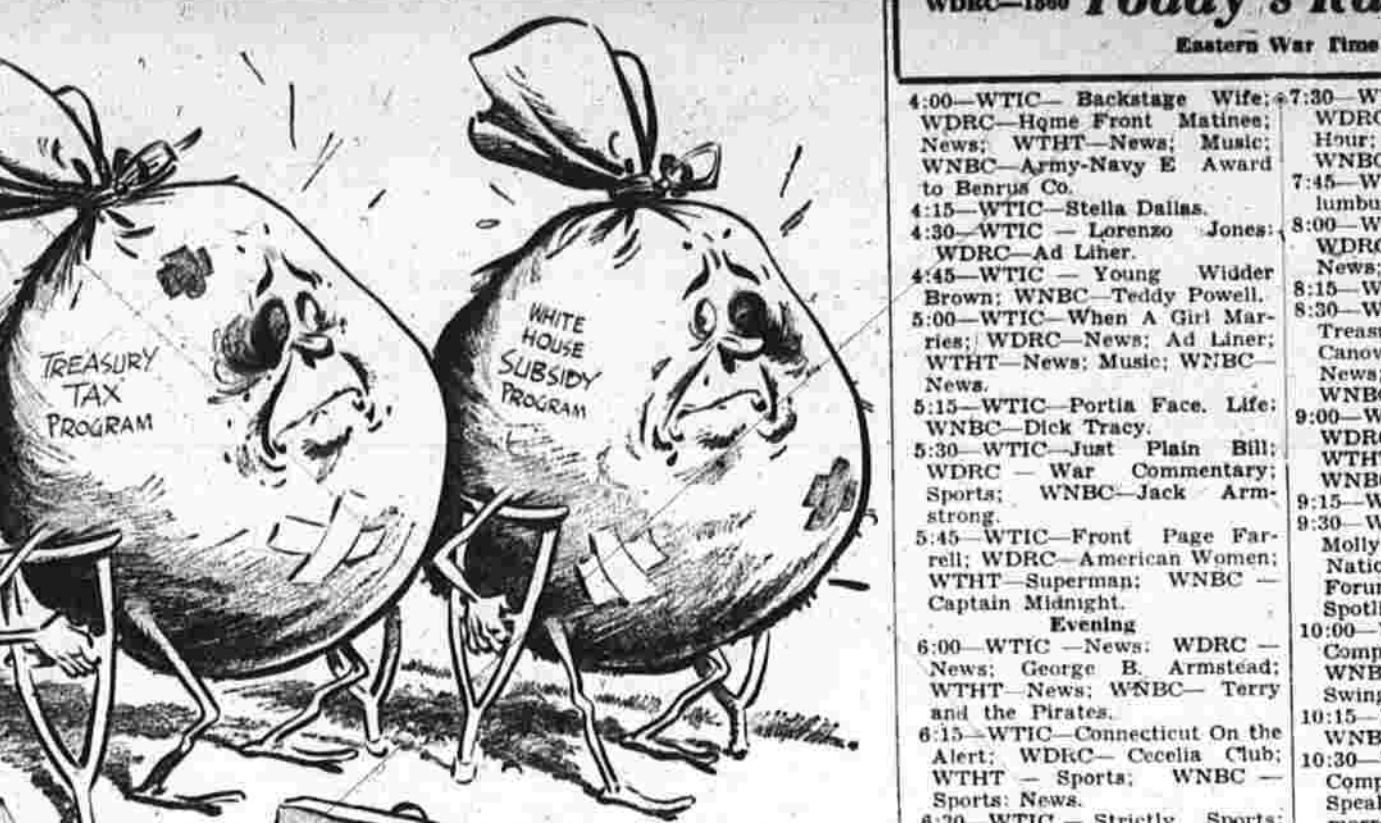
