Study Finds Dewey Tops Party Rivals

Hoover and Willkie Foreign Policy Views Second and Third Survey of Chiefs Show.

Chicago, Dec. 28.—(AP)—The foreign policy views of Gov. Thomas Dewey, Herbert Hoover and Wendell Willkie rank first, second and third in popularity, a survey of "grass roots" Republican leaders indicates, says the Republican Leader, national party magazine.

A poll on international subjects was conducted for the publication by C. M. Oehler, public opinion analyst. Of the questionnaires sent to 3,851 Republican county chairmen, state committee members and party workers, 2,800 were returned from approximately 20 per cent.

The question was "In general, do you favor or oppose the following foreign policy?" Dewey, Hoover and Willkie, in that order, were the most popular nominees.

Gov. John W. Bricker of Ohio; Sen. Charles McNary of Oregon; Sen. Robert Taft of Ohio; Sen. Vandenberg of Michigan; Sen. E. A. Tamm of Virginia; Sen. Warren of California; Gov. Dwight D. Eisenhower of New York; and Sen. Charles McNary of Oregon.

Reds Threaten German Flank Along Dnieper

Cut Two Railroads Out of Fast-Dwindling Network in Plunge Toward Rumania.

Moscow, Dec. 28.—(AP)—Gen. Nikolai Vatutin's 2nd Ukrainian Army swung southeast of Kiev today in a new, plunging thrust toward Rumania, the old Polish border, cutting two railroads out of the German's fast-dwindling network of communications and threatening the back of the enemy forces along the lower Dnieper river.

Vatutin's spectacular advance through the town of Andriushkivka, 120 miles from the Rumanian frontier, was preceded by a heavy artillery barrage. It carried his troops forward approximately 20 miles from the starting point of his offensive in the Brusilov sector to within 15 miles of the Zastavna lateral railway line.

The German Transcaucasus army announced the Germans had evacuated the Adriatic port of Ortona, in a grimly-declared "greatly superior enemy force," according to a dispatch from the north.

The Germans, turning Ortona into a "miniature Stalingrad," had been fighting the Canadians there for several days.

Both Canadian and Indian troops of the Eighth Army took numerous prisoners in the fighting for the port, a city of 8,000 American troops left Pezaro.

Meantime 11 miles below Pezaro, the British 1st Airborne Division, which had been ordered to capture the town of Ortona, was fighting the Germans.
