Jap Soldiers Sick of War

Not at All Sure of Victory, According to Available Prisoners.

With Chinese Forces in Northern Hunan Province, Dec. 20—(Delayed)—Japanese soldiers and civilians alike are sick of the war and not at all sure of victory, according to available Japanese prisoners.

This far, war correspondents touring this Chinese front have had an opportunity to question 18 prisoners, all Japanese except three Koreans.

Aspart from the fact that opinion gleaned from them were too few for any generalization, it is worth noting that the Chinese produced no enemy prisoners and that about half the prisoners interviewed were engineering or transport workers rather than actual combatants from whom fiery responses might have been forthcoming.

All Seem Embarrassed
None of the prisoners seemed embarrassed or in any way contrite. All showed bravado and none made patriotic declarations.

All provided a prompt reply to all questioning save one—called various titles Superior Private Hanamoto Miyoi, 24, from Fukushima, who took his time about answering when he was asked if he hadn't gotten a bullet in his chest.

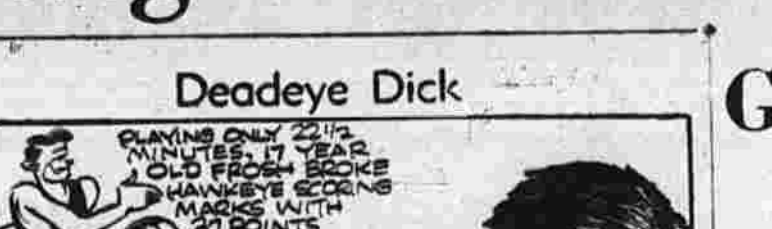
