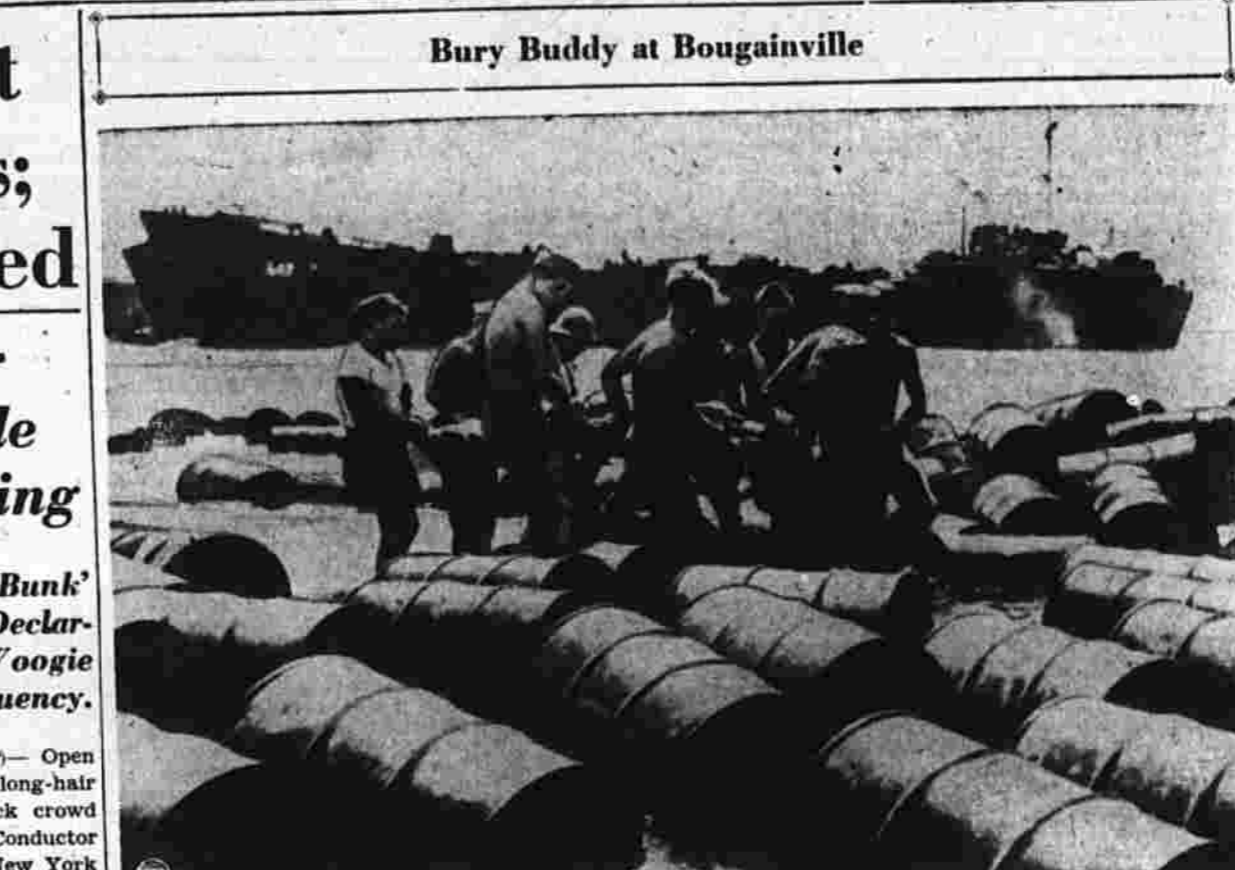

Special Speech Class Is Being Taught Here

Is First of Its Kind in the State; Considered Success by Teachers; Its Object.

For the past nine months, with but little publicity centered upon it, a special speech instruction class has been held in Manchester, weekly, for the benefit of pupils of local schools who have defective speech or muscular or structural mouth and throat impediments.

This first out-patient class of the Newington Home for Crippled Children has been very successful in teaching children of all ages the proper method of enunciation, enabling them to correct defects in speech that had been their bane since birth in many cases.

First in the state the speech correction class which has now operated in connection with the Manchester schools as a part of the out-patient aids of the Newington Home, is the first such class to be instituted in the state.

Holders of the good work shown in the treatment of speech defects goes to the Newington Home for Crippled Children through the director, Miss Edith Flavin of the department of Physio-therapy and Miss Meribah Leach, director of the clinic in speech correction, in cooperation with Superintendent of Schools Arthur H. Illing.

Classes in Newington to the school officials, noting that there were a number of children with speech defects more than a year ago, conferred with Miss Leach and plans were made to take these children selected for speech defects to the Newington Home for classes in speech correction.

These children destined to take the course in Newington were first selected by their teachers and referred to the actual nurse on duty, who made the final selection and recommendation. The children were transported during the fall and winter of 1911 and 1912 and there have since that time been no more children in the regular course of training under the direction of Miss Leach.

Difficulties arose with parents being unable to take their children to Newington, with the consequence that another method of conducting the class was devised. This was investigated.

Decided to Locate Here Superintendent of Schools Arthur Illing held a conference and it was determined that there were children in the local schools needing this type of speech training. After operations for cleft palate and other types of structural mouth defects, it was decided that an effort should be directed towards the establishment of an out-patient class for the treatment of these handicapped children here in Manchester.

Local Class Started Miss Leigh, the director of the Newington Home was cooperative when approached on the plan of establishing a class in speech instruction in Manchester. One day of each week, and the class was started. The class has been in operation for nine months with excellent results, each week Thursday in the Lincoln school.

This first class was started on March 31, 1913 and parents of the class members were present with the teachers and school nurses to witness the first demonstration. It was pointed out by the demonstrators and instructor, Miss Leach, that certain defects of the nose and throat, and illnesses of the same organs, often caused limitation of expression or defective form of expression or an impediment. After surgery, the child must then be taught anew the way to speak properly, to overcome the habits of speech earlier formed, and caused by the impediments before correction.

It was emphasized that the ability to absorb the new rules of speech to correct the old manner of speech was a slow process, involving special instruction and requiring much patience by both pupil and instructor.

There were 25 children in the first speech instruction class formed in Manchester. In the past eight months the membership has ranged from 25 to 45. Many local children having speech defects have not yet been examined for possible admission to the clinic.

Selected Through Schools The children are selected for the training class through the schools. Teachers report children in their classes having evident persistent speech defects, to the school nurse, and those boys and girls who had sufficiently defective in their speech to warrant correction. The class is examined by Miss Leach and they are admitted to the class.

The children in the present class come from several of the Manchester schools. The younger children entering the class for the first time are brought by the parents, the older ones reporting themselves to the school nurse. Among children of pre-school age, there are types of defects such as persistent "baby talk," and in children of the fifth and sixth grades, in which the pupils combine the sounds of "th" and "w" in their conversations and also correlative starting. Parents are quick to notice a slight improvement each week in the speech of their offspring, but in some instances parents often ex-

pect too rapid an improvement in speech. Superintendent of Schools, Arthur H. Illing, is convinced of the value of speech training for the children of Manchester, the net result being the production of better citizens by the removal of glaring speech defects and the elimination of a definite feeling of inferiority. Speech training and its consequent development, limits the child's aversion to taking part in the regular school activities, such as reading and reciting, creating an effective change in the child's outlook on life, Mr. Illing states.

Although a new program, Mr. Illing is convinced that local parents realize the value of the training given their children, and it is hoped that the course may be continued here and increased in numbers so that all those children with speech defects may share in this valuable training.

Reporter Visits Class A Herald reporter visited Miss Leach's class in speech instruction Thursday and gained at first hand valuable information concerning the methods of correction of faulty manner of speech, the psychological aspects of training, youngsters having such handicaps and the remarkable way in which the instructor analyzes each case and sets out a specific course of training in word sounds and groups of words containing sounds in the use of which the patient is deficient.

The two groups witnessed in class this week were from kindergarten age up to seventh grade age. The pupils sit in classes grouped around the instructor, Miss Leach, and as an introduction, and for the purpose of setting the child at ease and to eliminate any tension which may be present, Miss Leach asks each pupil simple questions about the past week, what has occurred to them in the week past, how their parents and little brothers and sisters are and gradually approaches the subject at hand through these questions.

Wins Child's Confidence By this psychological approach and the psychological approach the child attending the class for the first time is dissipated and opens the way easily to questions, refreshing their memories on the lesson of the week before, and what the instructor had said the child to do in "home-work" training. In sounding out words and sounds properly.

Then the actual lesson begins. Facing each child individually, Miss Leach enunciates clearly groups of sound combinations and phrases containing words and sounds in which the child is deficient.

If the pupil slips up or forgets for the moment details of formation, lessons, such as the proper position in placing lips, tongue or teeth in sounding words, the instructor describes carefully again the proper placement and, in the case of difficult enunciation, either a tongue depressor, holds the child's jaw in proper position for the sounding of the word.

Watches Mouth Formation No child is allowed to pass by a subject without first accurately sounding the words given, even to the point of repeating again and again the specific sounds desired. The pupil watches intently the facial expression of the instructor, trying in effect to emulate her in lips and facial formation in enunciation of the sound desired.

Miss Leach tries not to have the pupil depend too much upon observation, but she has the habit of upon their own memory of the form and manner of the right-way speaking.

Speech training is a slow process and many parents of children attending this class sometimes wonder why their child does not improve in the training. There are many things to consider in this type of training, the child's own physical and mental attitude towards the training before then, certain physical or mouth structure or speech structure hinderances which first must be overcome before the child can master the new sounds to any degree of perfection.

Signs of Progress "During the first few weeks of training," Miss Leach said, "no appreciable change may be noted. After a time there will be set up a sort of sound 'contusion,' in which the child will continue the new sounds being taught them, and the former sounds." This is an indication that they are making progress.

After the child has reached this stage in their training when they begin to "contuse" the old and correct sounds with the new being taught them, they gradually progress until they forget the old sounds and retain, with consistent training, the desired correct sounds.

Speech Training Invaluable Some of the phrases of words given them for sound instruction would be difficult to sound by persons, even adults, with no speech impediment, but the pupils soon masters these phrases under the capable teaching of Miss Leach.

Pupils of all ages take an intense interest in the training program. A trained children's nurse, Miss Leach knows how to approach each individual child, psychologically, treating each child as a unit in the training curriculum.

The speech training program as outlined and set forth here is of valuable aid to those children having speech defects, and though the program sometimes is slow, the results will be reflected in the production of better citizens through the elimination of faults of speech which otherwise would be a distinct handicap for life.

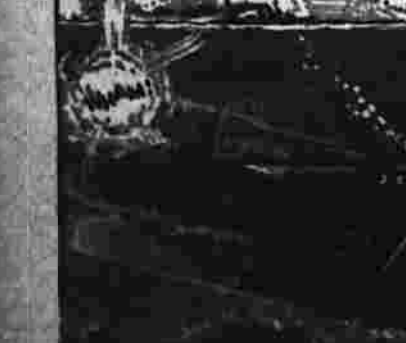
