Americans on Verge of Conquering Core of Enemy's System

Fighting Men, Tanks and Guns Pour Ashore to Annihilate Dwindling Jap Defenders; Preliminary Reports Tell of Amazingly Light Losses in Invasion of Marshalls.

U. S. Pacific Fleet Headquarters, Pearl Harbor, Feb. 4.—(AP)—Fighting men, tanks and guns, pouring ashore to annihilate the dwindling forces of Japanese defenders, appeared today on the verge of conquering the Marshall Islands, largest atoll in the Pacific.

Losses Under Expectation... Rear Admiral Richmond K. Turner, commander of the amphibious operation, said last night that the Japanese investment of the Gilberts—said to be the largest island group in the Pacific—had been expected.

Nazi Bomber Wins Praise Of Experts

Americans Decide New JUB8 'Is Rough and Ready and Plane to Inspire Respect'.

Washington, Feb. 4.—(AP)—American airmen, having tried out a sample, have decided that the new JUB8 is rough and ready and a plane to inspire respect at any time.

One of the twin-engine medium bombers came into Allied hands last September when a Luftwaffe pilot quit his job, took the plane and flew it to the British island of Cyprus in the eastern Mediterranean.

London, Feb. 4.—(AP)—A thirly-veiled warning that the Germans intend to defend Rome step by step, whatever the destruction entailed, it reported to have been conveyed to Pope Pius XII by the South Atlantic.

Post Office 'Out of Red' During Year

House Gets Bill Carrying Funds for Operation as Well as That of Treasury Dept.

Washington, Feb. 4.—(AP)—A \$1,218,576,777 bill carrying funds for the operation of the Treasury and Post Office departments for the 12 months starting July 1 was sent to the House floor today by the Appropriations committee.

Most of the \$1,218,576,777 was allotted to the Post Office department, which reported that during the fiscal period ended last June 30 it operated "out of the red" for the first time in 34 years.
