## Your Federal Income Tax

### Basin of Gain or Loss (Part 2)

The basis for determining gain or loss for Federal income tax purposes, and for other purposes, is determined by the taxpayer in payment for services rendered, in the case of real estate, or the fair market value of the property at the date of receipt. This basis is then adjusted for capital gains, such as depreciation, and adjustments in the case of real estate.

In the case of property acquired by gift, a distinction is made between property acquired before January 1, 1926, and property acquired by gift or transfer in trust (except by devise or bequest) after December 31, 1925. In the case of property acquired by gift or transfer in trust after December 31, 1925, the basis for determining the gain or loss is the fair market value at the time of the gift or transfer in trust.
