Home Secretary Busy With War Time Jobs

Average Day of Miss Jessie Reynolds Demonstrates Services Done by the Red Cross.

The office of the Home Secretary of the American Red Cross is the contact point between the man in service and the anxious parent, wife or children of the man fighting his country's battles and on the seas.

Manchester is fortunate in having in the person of Miss Jessie Reynolds, a Home Service Secretary who knows nearly all of the Manchester young men and women in service, and who has done an extremely valuable service for them in her official duties.

In order that the average person might know what types of services Miss Reynolds renders, and is daily rendering, for the local boys and girls in service, this article is written.

Miss Reynolds arrives at her office about 8:45 a. m. and immediately looks through her mail. In this morning's mail, she found a request from the Field Director in an Army camp to ascertain the home conditions of a local soldier, who was concerned about his family, also a request for a report from another Field Director for the Army Emergency Relief.

Before either of these communications could be acted upon, Miss Reynolds signed for two incoming telegrams, one from the Field Director asking for an immediate reply on home conditions of a local soldier who was greatly worried about his family and another wife asking for verification of a reported illness of a sailor's mother.

The home visits required by the telegrams were accordingly made by Miss Reynolds and the Field Director. The first visit was to the home of a local soldier who was greatly worried about his family and another wife asking for verification of a reported illness of a sailor's mother.

At 7 p. m. a call came in from the wife of a serviceman who was at home after being on active duty. She was reported quite sick and the nurse was asked to visit while she did on her own time. The doctor was called and during the evening the doctor's arrival, Miss Reynolds did what she could to make him comfortable.

The doctor recommended hospitalization as the patient needed constant care. The ambulance was called and Miss Reynolds accompanied the patient to the hospital. Again back at her home, Miss Reynolds retired. Then, at 1:30 a. m. the next morning the phone rang.

A telegram was read, asking for the verification of the illness of a serviceman's mother. Out and into the car in the darkness, Miss Reynolds drove to the boy's home and found that the particular mother, instead of being ill, was away attending a party.

That was but one day in the life of the Home Secretary of the American Red Cross in Manchester. Her day has been in the whirl of a quarter of a century in this capacity.

Every day she puts into the Red Cross goes into just this type of service, the greatest of which is to help the man in the uniform in the world whose only reward for long hours of service is the whole-hearted and continued support of the people.
