Democracy Can't Play Poker
The difficulties of formulating and conducting foreign policy in a democracy—or at least the difficulties of trying to play a clever game of foreign policy—seem to be particularly evident in the international oil situation.

Well, hold, until it is proved otherwise that America's announcement of an American government project for a pipeline across Arabia was an attempt on the part of those conducting foreign policy to deal themselves an ace for use in a poker game they planned to stage.

That "poker game" has now formally been organized and called. It is going to be an Anglo-American conference on the world oil situation. The stakes will be the whole of the future of the world. British foreign policy and diplomacy has many high cards, accumulated over years of successful, far-reaching empire policy. The very pipeline we propose to build, for instance, cuts straight through a section hitherto controlled unshakably under British political and economic domination. We have been a little bit bold, perhaps, in dealing ourselves an ace. Perhaps there is, in our so obvious preparation for this poker game, some element of poker bluff.

It is despite such poker game tactics, we are true to our principles, we are not playing the game to grab anything for ourselves. We merely to gain British practical access to the Atlantic Charter proposition that all the resources of the world should be freed from monopolistic control and held and managed in trusteeship for the benefit of all the world.

But when a democracy, presumably aiming at a good principle, tries to use poker game tactics in its effort to strengthen its position, it usually runs into trouble. And in this case, it is the American oil industry, backed by some elements of Congress, which seems determined to spoil the game. Its opposition to the pipeline in question raises doubt as to whether or not it will ever be built. There is no question, then, whether we really do hold the ace we intended to hold. Elements within our democracy, using their perfectly democratic privileges, are weakening the hand we intended to play. By contrast, Stalin, for instance, never would face the embarrassing question of having a foreign policy bluff meant for the outside world called by any of his own people.

Perhaps this all adds up to the fact that a democracy should not try to be cute or clever in its diplomacy, shouldn't, in fact, try to play poker at all. With every reason why the first card dealt to us is not a good one, it is better to play straight. It is better to play straight. It is better to play straight.
