Canberra, Australia, March 13.—(AP)—Australia's Army minister, Francis E. Forde, said in an interview today that it is galloping to the Australian public after four and a half years of war, during which Australia's forces fought in nearly every theater of the world, to read in a newspaper report that the Australians better get into the Pacific war themselves.

He said his comment was prompted by an editorial appearing in the Sydney Morning Herald (The Tribune) in an editorial dated March 12: "Rather than crying about the pay of American soldiers, the Australians had better be getting into the Pacific war themselves. They still retain severe restrictions against sending drafted troops beyond the area of Australia's direct interest."

"Australia has fulfilled every obligation to her Allies in this war not only in the Pacific but in all theaters and will continue to do so until final victory," Forde asserted.

In proportion to the population, Australia has been under arms as any Allied or enemy nation," he added.

### Cassino Devastated By Allied Air Power; 1,400 Tons Dropped

#### Central Reich Transport Official Taken by Death Today

London, March 13.—(AP)—Allied air power devastated Cassino today with history's greatest concentrated bombing attack, and Allied ground forces immediately charged in to drive the Germans from the rubble of the fortress town. More than 1,400 tons of bombs were hurled on a target area of less than a square mile by every type of Allied plane in an armada of 3,000 sorties.

Joseph B. Eastman, director of defense transportation at Washington's Pentagon, was taken by death today after a month's illness.

British and American artillery pounded out in heavy barrages from the morning—long bombing stopped.

On a main highway to Rome, 175 miles southeast of Cassino, and some 60 miles from the sea, the German forces of the Anzio invasion beachhead.

Gen. Ira C. Eaker threw every plane of his Mediterranean Command into a gigantic blow to smash the German grip on this town once and for all. They were shortly after dropping bombs and continued pounding the town until noon.

Then the artillery opened its fearful barrage and the waiting Allied tanks moved into the town to take the German forces out of the town.

Allied troops who had been holding out since they were cut off by the sea were withdrawn quietly during the night to give the bombers a free hand.

First reconnaissance photographs showed that the town had been leveled.

The attack was a surprise, as it was not expected to destroy every building in Cassino and pulverize the ancient stone houses, concealing countless guns blocking the Fifth Army's advance.
