The Army, Navy and Marine corps officers manned the medium bombers, dive-bombers and fighters which blasted Japanese barracks, gun positions and air strips in the Caroline Marshall bombing.

Fleet Air Wing two search planes also bombed the island, and Ujeland island west of the Marshalls.

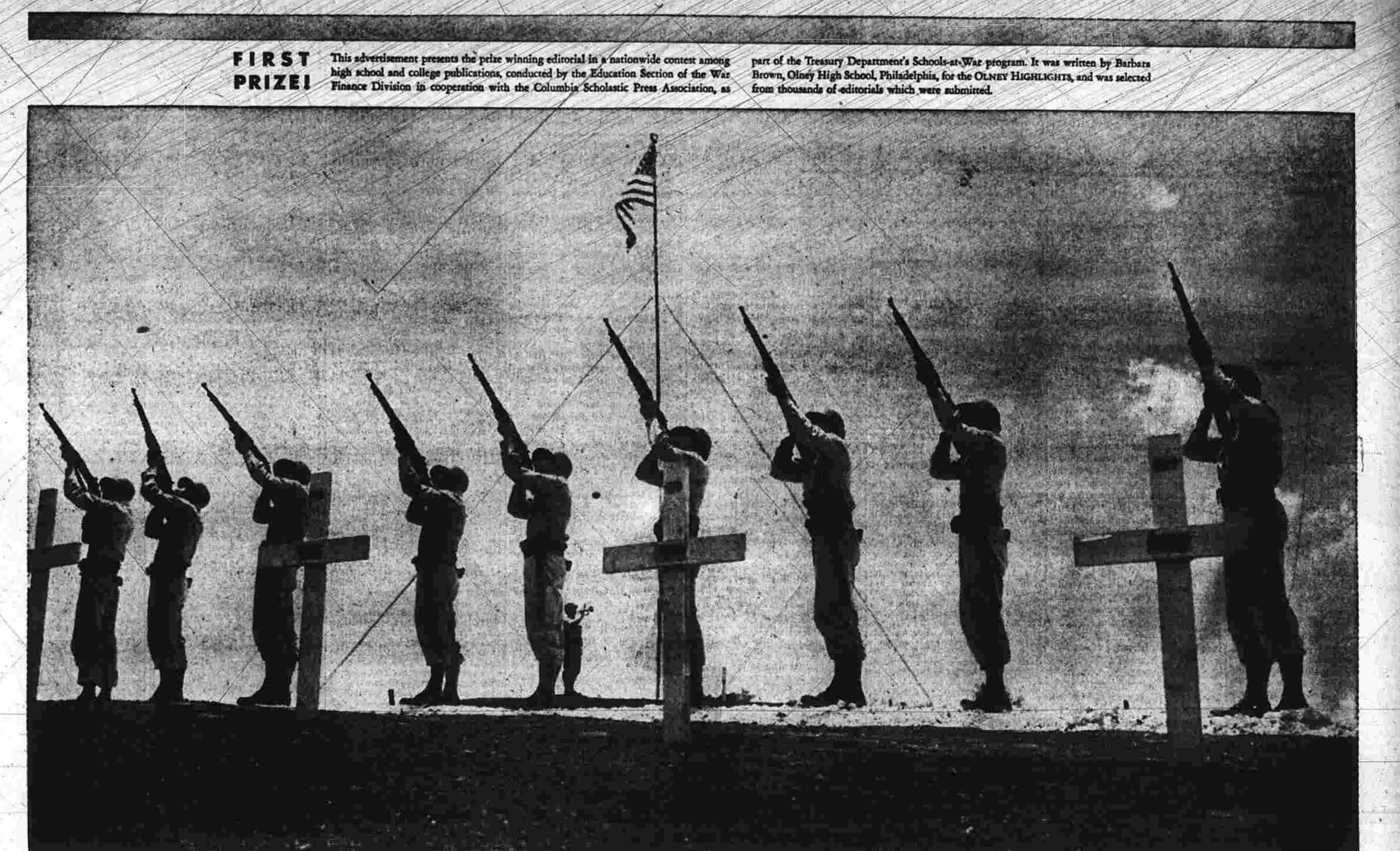
