The attack, which German bombers frequently attacked the British, was a surprise. No American bomber was lost in the raid. The attack was led by Major General Douglas M. Stinson, commander of the 8th Army Air Force. The bombers dropped high explosives and incendiary bombs on German positions in the area. 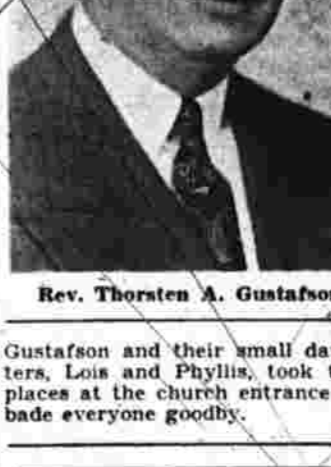
