Yanks' Casualties Heavy on Saipan; Resistance Stiff

Japs Drop Soft War On Saipan

Abandon Old Tactics of Withdrawing from Island Bases With Only Minor Defense.

Washington, July 1.—(AP)—The Japanese seem to have decided to fight—to have abandoned their tactics of withdrawing from island bases with only minor resistance, no resistance at all, in fact, in some instances such as at Kiska in the Aleutians.

This is demonstrated emphatically in the disclosure by Admiral Chester W. Nimitz, Pacific Fleet commander in chief, that 4,752 American troops have been some casualties of war as a result of the enemy stand on Saipan.

At least half of that 72,000-man force, the western Pacific Marine group in American hands, fighting hard fighting—continues through the sugar cane fields and along the rolling hills of Saipan. From Saipan's D-Day, June 14, through last Wednesday, American losses far exceeded the bitter Tarawa fight of the six months' Guadalcanal campaign.

Marines Bear Heaviest Loss The Marine assault force, as at Tarawa, bore the heaviest loss on Saipan—1,288 killed in action, 377 wounded; 827 missing. Army had 40 dead; 1,023 wounded; 81 missing.

Tarawa—Until now the costliest victory in Marine Corps history—claimed 1,028 dead and 2,357 wounded without a single member of Tarawa's dead, 968 were Guadalcanal, in six months of warfare, totaled 3,787 dead and 10,000 wounded.

In addition to the Japanese bodies found in Saipan's battle areas, many hundreds of dead and wounded were carried away by withdrawing troops. Therefore, Admiral Nimitz said, the Japanese estimate was possible of Nipponese losses.

Veteran Ninth Sparked D-Day Drives in Africa And on Normandy Front

Editor's Note: Since D Day marked the invasion of Normandy, the veteran Ninth Division has been mentioned frequently in front-line dispatches. This division has been reported to be in the vanguard of American forces, which captured Cherbourg. Here is the story of the fighting Ninth, whose men saw combat service on D Day in North Africa. Correspondence still withholds many details of battles in which they fought, but their part record is one of which any outfit could well be proud.

Ninth Division Correspondent
London.—The "Neglected Ninth," America's forgotten division during the African desert campaign, is at last coming into its own. Observers who were in action in the Mediterranean considered it probably the crack U. S. Army unit in the North African theater.

Through a series of happenstances, the Ninth always missed a hair getting the public acclaim that was its due.

The chief reason that the Ninth Division was so long neglected was that its regimental combat teams were fought attached to other units, which got the credit for the victories.

Ninth Mass Assault
Two of the Ninth's combat teams landed on D Day in North Africa, while the third landed only four days later. Fighting separate, its combat teams of the division took part in such notable battles as Kasserine and Faid and Maknassy and Djebel Chambi.

During these battles the Ninth's combat teams had been attached to such diverse units as the First Armored Division, the U. S. 82nd Airborne Division and the British Fifth Army. For security reasons the attachment to these divisions and corps were never announced.

Brush Lower ash
