### Kick Protocol About To Please de Gaulle

Washington—Linear as the State Department is concerned, protocol is "the rules prescribing etiquette in ceremonies of state" or in social functions attended by representatives of other countries to this nation.  
It is important, too, so important that the department has a division of experts, headed by Stanley Woodward, whose responsibility it is to figure out everything from who gets the first glass of grape punch to how many guns are fired for visiting dignitaries.  
This may seem silly to a lot of folks who think international relations would move faster if negotiators would take off their coats, slip down their collars and forget about how far from the head of the table they were seated.  
However, protocol has its uses, and some of them are vital, indeed, in the relations of one country with another. No better example exists than in the visit here by Gen. Charles de Gaulle.  
Officially Gen. de Gaulle is just another Free Frenchman as far as the United States is concerned. His National Committee of Liberation had not been recognized as even the interim government of liberated France. He could possibly be recognized as a head of state.  
But in the case of Gen. de Gaulle, the State Department virtually threw the protocol book out the window.  
The 17 guns that saluted his arrival were four short of the 21 fired for the head of a state, but that was about the only instance in which de Gaulle did not get full honors.  
Immediately after his arrival, the general was welcomed by the President. He stayed at comfortable Blair house, the historic mansion which is now the official boarding house for kings, queens, presidents and prime ministers who come to call.  
The State Department tossed him a banquet. The War Department, assisted in a measure by the Navy, gave him another sumptuous dinner.  
In addition to his talks with de Gaulle, the President, himself, planned a luncheon.  
Except for those four guns, no head of state could have been given any more attention. The object: To impress upon the general and Henri-Benigne Hoppenot, head of the French delegation in Washington, that even if the committee hadn't been formally recognized as the interim government of liberated France, there certainly wasn't any reason to believe it mightn't be if the French in France desire it.
