# Advisory Group Named To Aid Housing Study

To Formulate Post-War Needs as to Location, Quantity and Type; Study to Help.

Hartford, Aug. 28.—(AP)—The executive offices in the State Capitol today announced that Gov. Raymond W. Baldwin had approved the appointment of an advisory committee to the State Housing Authority to assist in formulating its survey of housing conditions both urban and rural, throughout Connecticut and in formulating plans for housing needs as to location, quantity and type.

The new advisory committee consists of 20 representatives of educational institutions, state agencies and organizations covering a variety of interests.

The committee's recommendations concerning post-war housing, the governor stated, would be of assistance to the construction industry and its suppliers of lumber, brick, cement and hardware in determining where a demand exists for new dwellings and what desirable building projects resulting in employment to those doing the work.

# Plan to Police World Looms

Soviet, American and British Working Toward Compromise

Washington, Aug. 28.—(AP)—Soviet, American and British delegates to the Dumbarton Oaks security conference worked today toward agreement—possibly a three-day compromise—on the most effective way to organize forces for suppressing future aggressor nations.

As the historic preliminary talks went into their second week, it was learned that two principal ideas have been developed thus far. One is a Russian proposal for an international air corps. The Russian delegation is understood to be strongly in favor of the creation of such a corps but is backing it strongly with the argument that it would provide a ready means of striking in any part of the world where trouble threatened.

Plan Suggested by Americans

The American delegation has suggested a plan by which each of the post-war nations would be required to contribute a certain number of troops to a common pool. The troops would be used for the purpose of maintaining peace in the world.

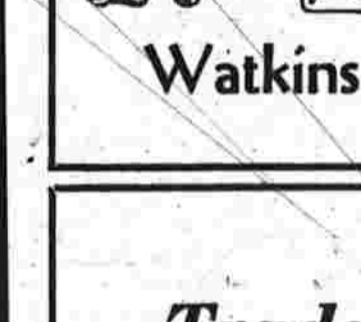

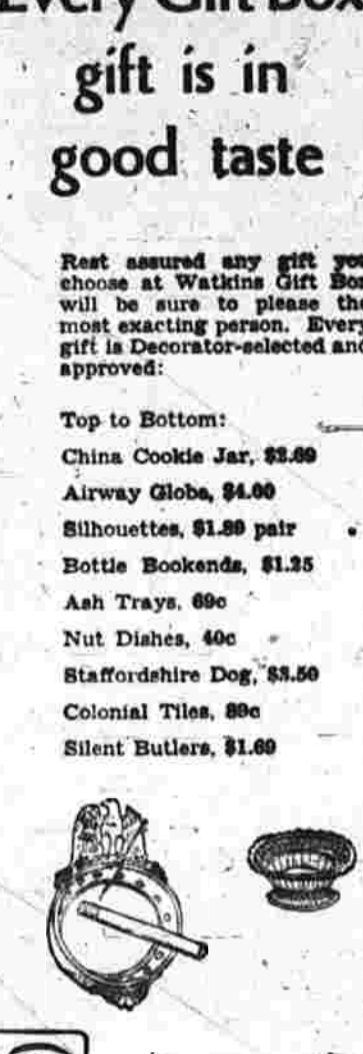

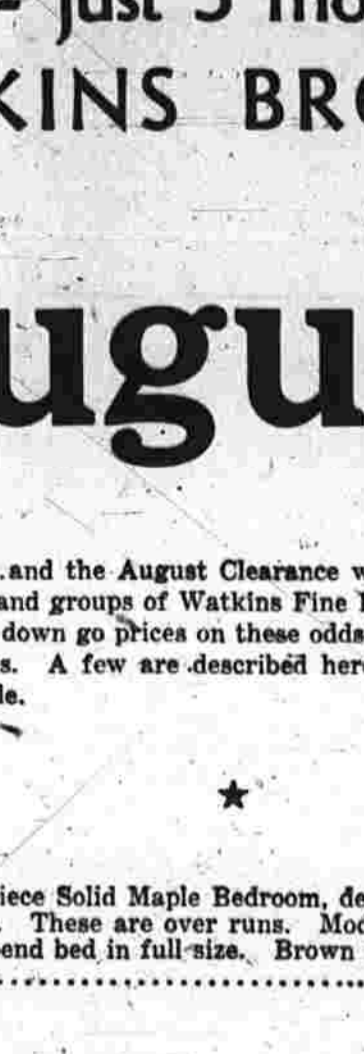
