Recess Called In Jail Probe

Nine Witnesses Heard Already in Investigation in New Haven

New Haven, Sept. 12.—(AP)—State Referee Carl Foster, sitting as a "one-man grand jury" to conduct a secret inquiry into the slaying of the New Haven country club, called a recess today after hearing testimony from 19 witnesses, some of them former inmates.

The investigation was scheduled to resume tomorrow, and court-house observers predicted it would not end until next week.

Two former jail employees, a bank teller and an auditor for the state department were the first witnesses summoned when the hearing began.

The nature of the testimony given by the witnesses was not disclosed, although State's Attorney Abraham S. Ullman characterized some of yesterday's witnesses as "extremely reluctant."

Storm Brings Suspense To Pacific Landings

Officers Take Big Chances As They Come in to Coral Fields After Bombing Trips.

Advanced Southwest Pacific Airbase, Aug. 28.—(Delayed)—If you want some excitement, perch yourself on a hill of excavated coral at either end of one of these Pacific island air strips on a stormy afternoon and watch the bombers land on a strike against Palau or Yap or Truk.

Leut. John C. Machiak, 2325 East Grand Blvd., Detroit, air engineer for this 13th Army Air Corps base, and I watched the Palau strike land yesterday in a 30-mile cross wind and in visibility ranging from zero to 300 feet. Machiak's job is to repair the strip after a crash and it looked for awhile as though he might have some work to do.

The first of the Palau bombers—11 hours in the air and gasoline low—landed at 4:30 p. m. A rain squall half a mile offshore was closing in. The visibility was still good but the cross wind was terrific.

Lurches Against Wind

The whole first squadron and half of the second landed in a series of lurches against the wind before the squall touched the island and "knocked" in the far end of the strip. The lower was green-lighting the planes frantically as the storm crept down the strip.

Help England As Our Duty

Strong United Kingdom Is a Strong United States, Says Speaker.

Akron, O., Sept. 12.—(AP)—Charles P. Taft, director of the state department's office of wartime economic affairs, declared today that it is "essential for our national interest to have a strong England."

In what amounted to a policy pronouncement on post-war relations with the United Kingdom, he also declared that "we must find ways to help them solve their financial problem."

With respect to Europe generally, he said that once the war is ended there the countries must be restored to economic health as quickly as possible. He predicted that "Europe as a whole can be largely self-sufficient in the items essential to life."

"The latest news from France supports this view to a surprising degree," Taft said in a speech prepared for a joint meeting of the Rotary club and Chamber of Commerce here.

Reconstruction Goods

"The goods we want to send most are reconstruction goods for transportation and power, and raw materials for manufacturing of various important kinds. The sooner we can get these countries on an export basis, the sooner we can sell them our products."

Taft presented both sides of the issue over whether import, export and financial controls over United States foreign trade should be relaxed immediately upon victory in Europe and he said the time had come for action on these measures but avoided making any commitments himself.
