Papers Checked and Soldiers Given Record of Civilian and Military Occupational Training

Washington, Sept. 27 — An order about to be discharged back into civilian life is sent to a separation center at Army camps across the country.

There, his papers are checked and he is given a record — called a separation qualification record — of his civilian and military occupational training.

Gov. Baldwin told his Stamford audience that the people of Connecticut were turned away from the New Deal Democratic party by the war.

"This is not a New Deal war or a Democratic war or a Republican war," he declared. "It is a people's war, and the record of Connecticut shows that we have considered it just that here at home."

The governor said that the courage and fighting ability of Connecticut men have been demonstrated on all the battlefields of the world.

Face Future With Confidence "We here at home have backed the war with confidence," he said. "We face the future with confidence."

McMahon speaking before the Democratic gathering at Bridgeport, said that he has been a Republican opponent, Senator John A. Danaher, who said, implied that he would have been friendly with Hitler.
