

Four From State

With the 175th Field Artillery Battallion, the first American unit to fire its howitzers on the Nazis in this war, is now participating in the Fifth Army offensive driving towards the Po river in Italy.

The distinguished battalion of which he is a member, has been in action on the Italian front since landing at Salerne over a year ago. During the initial months of the campaign the 175th made five perilous crossings of the Volturno within a period of 40 days and on each fording quickly tooks up positions to blast a path for the advancing 168th Infantry Regiman.

At the battle for Cassino, the unit played a conspicuous part in the long bombardment of the German stronghold, finally being pulled out of the sector and sent to Annio for the powerful drive culminating in the capture of Rome. Not stopping to rest at the Italian capital, the battalion drove retentlessly north, firing mercliess barrages at the enemy as they retreated from the important ports, Civitavecchia and Leghorn and continued the dramatic push over the Arno river, resulting in the capture of Pisa and Florence. Facing its third rainy winter in combat, the 175th is now engaged in the difficult drive forcing the enemy into northern Italy.

Originally a Minnesoita National Guard organization, the 175th was shipped to the British Isles in May, 1942 as part of the 24th "Red Bull" Division, the first unit
