Record Registration Indicated for Cities

Soldier and Other Absentee Ballots Being Returned in Ratio of One to Three Sought.

New Haven, Oct. 14.—(AP)—A look around Connecticut three weeks before the election shows a fairly consistent trend in only two directions—soldier and other absentee ballots have thus far come back in a ratio of a little better than one to every three asked for, and a record registration is indicated in many larger cities.

Observers of the picture in decision mixed, and will be until election boards cease to make new voters.

While Hartford reports that in the new registration has not been as high as anticipated, with 6,532 new voters since last year, the populous Bridgeport has already looked 7,500 new voters and expects nearly as many more to boost the voting lists from over 80,000 to somewhere near 70,000 for a record.

May Mean Large Increase

The number of new voters in the Park City is expected to be the greatest since 1928 when 20,000 were made but, of course, with shifting populations and continued depletion of males due to the draft and industrial changes, large totals total not only here but elsewhere throughout the state.

Waterbury officials, with an anticipated 5,000 increase in registration over 1940, when it was 20,000 were eligible to vote, report that more voters than ever have declined to declare their party preferences when given an opportunity to do so.

Of 600, however, who enrolled since Jan. 1 and who, elected to declare a preference, the tally stood this way: Democrats, 361; Republicans, 204.

In other years, political observers said, Democrats at Waterbury have outnumbered Republicans two or three to one on such occasions.

Similar Situation Found

A somewhat similar situation was found in Hartford, where Andrew G. Nystrom, Republican registrar of voters, asserted that, whereas four years ago the declaration of preference ran four and a half to one in favor of the Democratic party, this year's new voters were declaring a Democratic preference 3 to 1 ratio of only two to one.

Nystrom estimated, however, that at least 40 per cent of new voters were not recording a preference for any party.

With a bare pickup in the number of making new voters expected starting today and continuing through next week, in many places, the picture may change considerably, but, New Haven, nearly as large as Hartford, has 20,000 eligible voters against approximately the same number in 1940.

Danbury Registration Break

Danbury registration of new voters has been brisk and the total is expected to be much higher than in any previous election year. Norwich expects approximately 1,000 more voting eligibles and Torrington also looks for a bumper year with 1,010 new voters up to yesterday.

The New Britain registration is showing a considerable increase with a total of 20,969 new registered and two days yet to go against a 1940 registration of 20,467.

Leicester also is sharp in New London where 500 new voters are to be sworn in today and as many more next Saturday to bring the expected eligible electors up to 15,000, about the same number as in the last presidential election.


