

Whole German Stand In Holland Menaced; West Anchor Seized

London, Oct. 28.—(P)—The whole German stand in southwestern Holland is collapsing, front dispatches declared today, as British-Canadian columns, raced toward the enemy's last two escape bridges in an effort to cut off perhaps 40,000 Nazi troops before the Meuse (dunes) river. Canadian soldiers seized the German's western anchor of Bergen op Zoom without a fight and within a mile of the stronghold of Roosendaal.
