









Says Armistice Just Beginning

Victory Will Mark Our Start in Fight on Forces Of Evil, Says Pastor.

The sanctuary of South Methodist church was entirely filled with many people sitting in the service chapel for that church's Armistice service of Memory and Honor for the men and women in the armed forces. Those present heard Rev. W. Ralph Ward, Jr., minister of the church declare that we must resolve here and now that Armistice day whether we think of the one who will observe it on the final V day of this war is not the end but the beginning of our great struggle against the forces of evil.

"Our loved ones are fighting for political democracy, we here at home no matter what the cost must learn to live for the political democracy. Our loved ones are fighting to end the threat of war as the basis for a social order, we here at home must learn to live with people of all races and creeds. Our loved ones are giving their all to overthrow the forces of evil that threaten to establish a new spirit."

New Spirit Referring to the presence of the patriotic and veteran groups, and representatives of the American Red Cross Mr. Ward asserted that the service itself was a witness of a "new spirit abroad in our community which will make the days of demobilization meet the needs of the men as they come home from war." "Nothing," urged Mr. Ward, "should so play into the hands of the worst enemies of America as to let a spirit of misunderstanding and ill will grow up between those who have sacrificed in this war on the battlefield, and those who have made sacrifices though not always so obvious as dramatic as the production, industrial and in many other places on the home front."

At the center of the altar was a large white cross held by two candles in memory of D. Arthur Lawrence, and Clifford Miles McKinney who have lost their lives in this war, and one hundred and sixty-three candles in honor of those who have blue stars on the South church service flag. Following the meditation these candles were lighted by T. Sergt. Norman Johnson and Corp. Raymond Backwell of Co. H 2d Inf. Bn. of the Connecticut State Guard at the names of each was read. After the lighting of the two gold candles with the congregation standing in silence taps were played by Robert Lyons of the Salvation Army. The altar was surrounded by memorial flowers given in memory of A. Willard Case and Bishop William F. Anderson who presided at the South church dedication Nov. 1, 1924, by Mr. and Mrs. Albert L. Crowell, in memory of D. Arthur Lawrence by Mrs. Gertrude Lawrence and Audrey; and in memory of Clifford Miles McKinney by his family. Mr. and Mrs. William McKinney, A large bouquet of flowers decorated the pulpit and were given by the Blood Donor's Service of the American Red Cross in appreciation of the service of South church for its service.

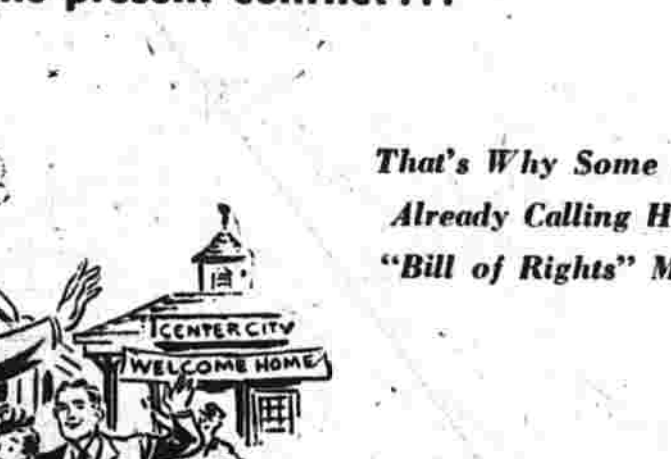

### Campaign Approaches Climax in Connecticut

Candidates Make Next-To-Last Appeal for Votes in Person and Over Radio.

By The Associated Press. The 1944 campaign approached a climax in Connecticut last night with candidates for national and state offices making their next-to-last appeals for votes in person and over the radio in wide-spread sections of the state.

Former Gov. Robert A. Hurley, speaking at the Jewish Community center in New Haven Sunday, asserted that "no man in America is more responsible than President Roosevelt for the opening of a second front in western Europe."

Gov. Raymond E. Baldwin, Republican seeking re-election, declared in radio broadcast from his party in Connecticut, would be able to cope with the post-war problems of tomorrow because of adequate preparations that were being made now.

Senator John A. Danaher, Democrat, speaking at the Y.M.C.A. Saturday afternoon, said that "Communism is no real issue, either primary or secondary, in this campaign."

Senator Danaher said, "The Communists do not support the Republican party," he said, "they support only the candidate or only the side which they can ultimately use for their own ends."

### Asks Return Of Veterans

Compton Asks Intercession by Stimson in South Pacific Area.

New Haven, Nov. 6.—(AP)—Rep. Rufus Compton (R., Conn.) today announced that he had asked Secretary of War Stimson "to intercede with the commander in the South Pacific war area so that units of Connecticut soldiers who have served continuously in that area for more than 30 months can be returned to their homes before Christmas."

No Shortage of Shipping. Pointing out that the War department had asserted there is no shortage of shipping to take men to this country—only to return them to the South Pacific—Compton said in a letter to the secretary of war, "I, therefore, would appear that in view of two facts: 1. The presence of an adequate number of troops in the locality in which these men are shipping for their return to this country; and 2. The availability of a military nature why these boys cannot be returned promptly. Any thought of returning them to the South Pacific would be inadvisable in the extreme."

Swing of Independent Voters. "Because of the magnificent fighting campaign that Gov. Thomas E. Dewey has waged, there has been a swing of the vote decided and independent voters to the Republican column, which in the past four or five days has become a tide."

Strength Increasing Daily. "The tremendous strength of Governor Baldwin with all types of voters regardless of party affiliation has been demonstrated in every part of the state. The strength of Senator John A. Danaher and the other members of the Republican team, Lieut. Gov. William L. Hadden, Secretary of State Francis Rodick, Treasurer Carl M. Sharpe, Comptroller Fred Zeller and Congressman-at-large R. J. Monkiewicz, has been increasing each day and it has gained momentum that will carry through the whole ticket."
