Guard Units Battle Japs In Solomons

Record of Manchester National Guard Units Excellent in Munda Battle; Suffer Losses

Almost a year before Pearl Harbor, Manchester's two former National Guard units—Company K and the Anti-Tank Company—16th Division, 43rd Division were Federalized and mobilized for Federal service at the State Armory in Manchester.

The units were commanded at that time by Captain William Taylor of East Hartford and Captain Raymond E. Hagood and the personnel of the two units were in the main Manchester boys who had served in the National Guard for one or more enlistments.

On March 12, 1941 the two companies left town for Camp Blanding, Florida. The unit will perhaps never return again to this army as a unit, for in the passing years only perhaps ten or a dozen men, originally from Manchester, are now in either the Anti-Tank Company or Company K of the 169th.

Before the units left, many of the former officers failed to pass the rigid physical examinations necessary for combat service. The commanding officer of the regiment, Colonel Joseph Nolan, World War I officer of the 102nd Regiment, 26th Division, failed to pass the required physical examination and upon leaving Connecticut the regiment was commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Kenneth M. Cramer of Waterbury, now a Brigadier General.

These two units of the National Guard of Connecticut in this war—arrived in Florida early in April and immediately began intensive training to fit them for the arduous service ahead of them in the South Pacific.

During their stay at Camp Blanding the 43rd took part in Army Corps maneuvers and later the division was ordered to Camp Shelby, Mississippi. It was at this location that the first Manchester boy to die in this war, Corporal Alexander Gurski of 110 Congress street, suffered fatal injuries in a night maneuver on July 14, 1942.

Home Front Here Plays Its Part in Winning War

Brief History of Activities in First Years as Town Sent Its Boys to World Battlefields

While the men-at-arms of Manchester have been fighting ashore and afloat, the people on the home front have been quietly going about the business of producing the things of war, and fortifying the home front in event of possible invasion.

Weighted in the light of what the others have done, the home front effort was of the most vital and the residents responded to the demand of the military and have adhered to the regulations until now in the town is pronounced a "non-critical" area.

For many months Manchester parents and friends took brief time off from their work to bid goodbye to their sons at depot and as they departed for Fort Devens and later New Haven. There were many stirring words and a few tears.

Seven Manchester men made the supreme sacrifice in 1942, mostly in the first great battles of the South Pacific. In 1943 the toll mounted to 21 deaths in action, including several Manchester sons in the bitter battle for the Munda airfield on New Georgia Island.

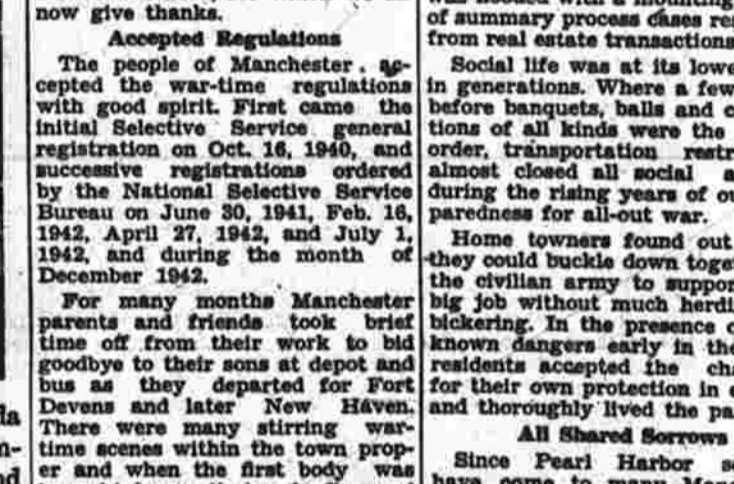

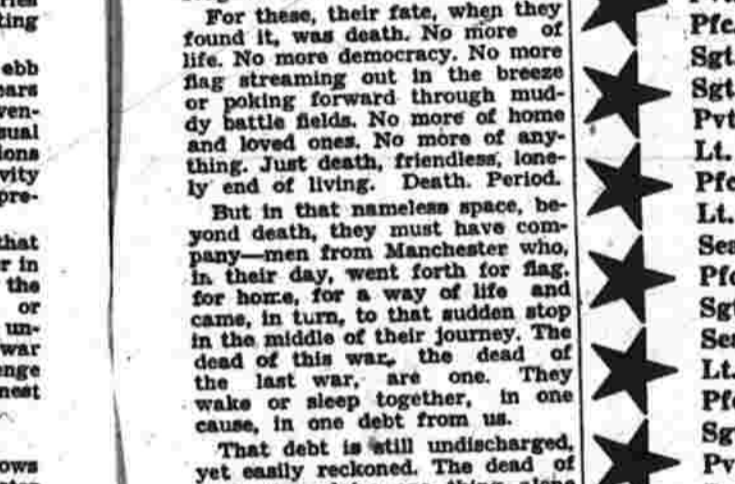
Munda Cemetery, New Georgia, So. Pacific

Over 50 Were Wounded So Far in Present War

List Also Given in This Article of Those Missing and Prisoners of War; The Names

The list of Manchester's wounded, missing and prisoners of war mounts to relative proportions to those who have made the supreme sacrifice. The unofficial list shows 55 men wounded, 12 missing in action and seven prisoners of war.

Within the first few months of the vicious land and sea warfare in the South Pacific, all reports were failures. As the first Manchester men from this war were listed as missing in action, they were listed as missing in action.

Of the 55 men wounded, five were officers and 50 were non-commissioned officers. Seven were non-commissioned officers and two private soldiers. Two of the seven listed as prisoners of war were officers, four were non-commissioned officers.

A few interesting contrasts appear in this three-year listing of sacrifices. For instance, one soldier was wounded in action in Italy. Pvt. George J. Agostinelli, exactly six months to the day he was drafted. And exactly two years after he was drafted—before it was not—another local boy was stationed at the army in Manchester.

Of the 120 casualties so far incurred in World War II, the Army has sustained 34 deaths, 50 wounded, 12 missing in action and six are prisoners of war. The Navy has seven dead and one wounded. The Coast Guard has one dead and four wounded. The Merchant Marine has one death and one missing in service.

Which Party Will Win Next National Race?

Republicans Get Next Big Chance in Presidential Election in 1948; Lot Can Happen

Washington, Nov. 11.—Where do the Democrats and Republicans go from here?

The Republicans, benched for 16 years, get their best chance in the presidential election of 1948.

The Democrats, repeatedly winning with Mr. Roosevelt, this year did it by about three million votes, the narrowest popular vote since 1912.

In the last four elections the Democrats won by an electoral landslide. It's the electoral vote which counts.

In those four elections the Republican electoral vote was not enough to win one election. Hoover got 59, Landon 8, Willis 2, and Dewey 39.

That's only 248 in four tries. In any one election the winning candidate must get at least 266 of the total 531 electoral votes.

Lot Can Happen in Four Years

A lot can happen to the Democrats and Republicans in the next four years.

Some factors certainly add to the Democrats' chances:

1. Voters' unwillingness to change the leadership in the middle of war and delicate peace plans; confidence in Mr. Roosevelt's leadership; and confidence in the Democratic Congress.

2. The war almost certainly will be over. Peace plans will be made. The Democrats will be in a position to build up a congressional record more than that of any other party.

3. Questions and problems here are some questions and problems about both parties that need to be solved.

4. The Democrats build up some use as a successor to himself in 1948, a standstill Democrat with no support.

5. The CIO Political Action Committee, which has 10 million shares in the Democratic victory, continues. It has found labor a political force.

6. If it continues, it will alienate the Democrats.

7. But it's not certain the CIO would support the Democrats in 1948. It could support the Republicans.
