New Haven, Nov. 20. (AP) - A worn-out flange on the wheel of a loaded gasoline tank car caused the accident Saturday that resulted in a spectacular three-alarm fire in the railroad cut east of New York.

The spokesman said the tank car was derailed when the left forward wheel with the worn flange struck a switch point just east of the Fair street bridge and lurched from the track on a curved track.

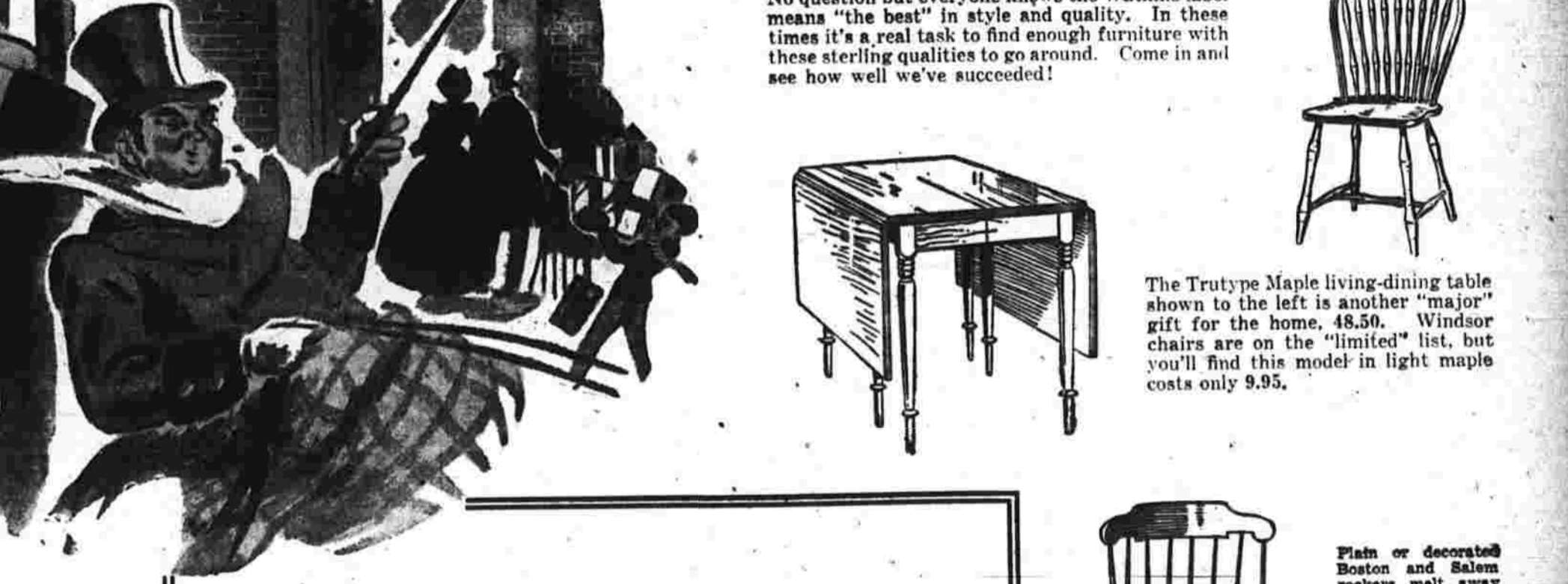
