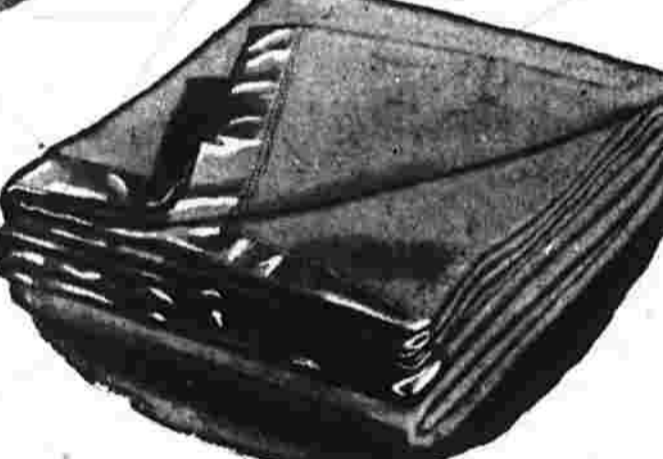

Five-starred Tokyo, its defenses admittedly penetrated twice in five hours Wednesday (U. S. time) by Super-Fortresses, is getting a foretaste of a campaign "to destroy the industrial area of Tokyo where some of Japan's heaviest war-making industries are concentrated."
