Pay Increase Set March 18. Order Affecting Retail Outlets in State Effective. Hartford, Jan. 25.—Connecticut's department, drug and grocery stores and other retail outlets will begin paying additional pay a minimum of 42¢ for a 44-hour week beginning March 18. That is the effective date, Deputy Labor Commissioner William G. Ezrin said yesterday, of the state's new minimum wage order signed recently by Labor Commissioner John J. Egan and designed to end the pay dispute between the state's retail establishments. The order will also benefit by the order. Ezrin pointed out, calling attention to the 44-hour weekly minimum provided for them for a 44-hour week. And under the new order the minimum pay of part time workers also will be increased. From 37¢ an hour to 40¢ an hour, and over time will be paid at the rate of time and a quarter. Ezrin said the order was prepared last year by the department's Merit Board and has been in effect since then. He said the new order with detailed explanations of each item will be mailed next week to all retail establishments.

Short of Manpower For Packing Plants; 193,000 Remain Out. No Immediate Resumption of Normal Operations Indicated After Federal Seizure Today; CIO Strikers Refuse to Return Because Increases in Wages Not Specified. By The Associated Press. Most of the nation's meat packing plants, strike-bound for 10 days, were operated by the Federal government today but insufficient manpower because of refusal of 193,000 CIO strikers to return to work indicated no immediate resumption to normal operations. Next Move Not Disclosed. The government's next move in getting the CIO strikers off the picket lines and back into the plants, managed plants to help bring fresh meat supplies to the nation's dinner tables was not immediately disclosed. The union held to its decision not to return to work until the plants because it said President Truman's seizure order failed to specify wage increases for the strikers. The AFL union whose 60,000 members had walked out in the wage dispute with packers, had been ordered to go back to work. A CIO official had declared a "temporary truce" in the strike. Notices of the presidential seizure order were posted on most of the 124 meat packing plants in 19 companies, before the formal possession by the government. A "voluntary action" and without ceremony, Clyde G. Armstrong, government representative for President Truman and Secretary of Agriculture Anderson, was in charge of the operations in Chicago. No Disturbances Reported. Early there were no disturbances reported. In Chicago, CIO pickets remained at the workers' large stockyards, despite Federal orders. Reports from other CIO locals indicated the lines would not be removed. Lewis J. Clark, president of the CIO United Packinghouse Workers, made no comment immediately. (Continued on Page Four)
