Bids Being Made Now For November Votes

Democrats Have Controlled House Since 1931; Both Parties Fire Broadside Now

Washington, Jan. 30.—(AP)—They're out, and you, the voters, are going to have to listen to it and make up your mind: Democrats against Republicans.

House Democrats have controlled the House since 1931. They've won 234, or 43 more than the 191 which the Republicans have. In addition, two minor parties are represented. And there are six vacant seats.

Majority on All Committees Having a majority in the full House, the Democrats also have a majority on all the committees. They've won 100 of the 100 seats on the committees.

Democrats are hardy back at work after Christmas recess when Joseph W. Martin, Jr., Massachusetts Republican, took to the air to say: "Congress needs to tell you that the administration of our national affairs is just in condition. We all know American has been in a state of confusion."

House To Map Out Strategy Martin is leader of the Republicans in the House. He's the job to map out the strategy which he hopes will make the Republicans look good.

He made the statement in a radio speech Friday, Jan. 18. Not to be outdone, Ben John W. McCormack, also of Massachusetts but leader of the Democrats in the House, said in a radio talk last week later.

Record of the Democratic party since March, 1933, when the Republicans were ousted from their position and lack of leadership, has been one of progressive and constructive service in the House.

So it went on. Democrats trying to take the skin off the Democrats and McCormack trying to pull the skin off the Republicans.

Congressmen, themselves, will probably let the Democrats back home from now until next November. Every two years the entire House of Representatives stands for re-election. In the Senate which has 96 seats, only one-third, or 32 senators, have to run for re-election every two years.

Bomb Plot Known Outside Germany The 1944 bomb plot against Adolf Hitler was known to the late President Roosevelt, Prime Minister Churchill, high Vatican officials and other persons outside Germany, according to a document published by the War Relocation Authority.

Others reported to have known of the plot in advance were Field Marshal Baron Carl Gustaf of Sweden, Marshal Pietro Badoglio of Italy, General Andorak of Hungary and two de Gaulle officials who operated in the German-occupied zone.

However, he added in an interview, "The solution is not to be found in a farm strike but in legislative action by Congress to protect the people's food supply."

Fred Bailey, legislative representative of the National Grange, told a reporter he did not believe farmers would be justified in withholding food from "120,000,000 Americans just because a million or so are on strike."

Both O'Neal and Bailey, as well as Agriculture department officials, expressed the view that an effective strike would be impossible because of the nature and the pervasiveness of the production. They pointed out that unlike the output of industrial products, it is impossible to halt the production of milk, eggs, and other farm products.
