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Famous \$10,000 Wall Here Makes Way for New Block

Preparations for the construction of the new business block at the corner of St. James' and Main streets, about 250 feet of concrete wall from St. James' street south of Main street had to be demolished when the wall was erected about 1920. Main street, at one time, was much wider than at present. Several years ago the town decided that there was too much roadway to keep in shape and a large portion of the street on the east side of Main street, from Court street to Forest street, was torn up and the abutting property owners.

When the decision was made to widen the road, several feet of this wall was again given back to the town, beginning at Park street and extending to Forest street. The St. James' church property at Forest street had a hedge along the Main street frontage which was set back and the new line of the sidewalk and new walks were constructed.

The property from St. James street to Forest street, on Main street, was then owned by the late James W. Cheney heirs. They agreed to give the land back to the town upon the erection of the concrete wall along the west side of

AP Directors Hear Benton

Appears in Connection With Ending of Service to Federal Agency

New York, April 24.—William Benton, assistant secretary of state, appeared before the Board of Directors of the Associated Press yesterday in connection with the AP's termination of its news service to the state department for shortwave broadcasting.

After the meeting Benton told newspapermen: "After listening very courteously and attentively to my presentation for an hour, then I answered questions for 45 minutes. I am very grateful to the board for having afforded me this opportunity."

Benton said the discussion dealt largely with the question of short-wave broadcasting and added there was nothing further he could say.

Boyle's COLUMN

By Hal Boyle

Rome, April 24.—Italy is one of the most hopeless countries in the western world today because its people feel it is hopeless for them to make both ends meet, the problem of the masses in all countries, and all alike.

Their morale has been beaten to pieces on the anvil of adversity and low wages by the hammer of high prices. This feeling that there is little use in working because their labor brings them no adequate return has spread like a wave of disaster through the nation, paralyzing efforts at personal and civic recovery from the ruin of war.

"Don't Care" Attitude

And the reflex defensive result of this feeling of hopelessness in the individual is a "don't care" attitude about his job, a lowering of all moral standards and a cynical indifference to everything except his own belly and his own amusement.

Authorities estimate that if it takes a salary of 20,000 lire a month—about \$28—for a family of five to buy the food needed to keep them in good health.

Yet the average Italian office or technical worker, including the college graduate, does not average better than half that amount. The father must spend virtually his entire wages for food for his wife and children.

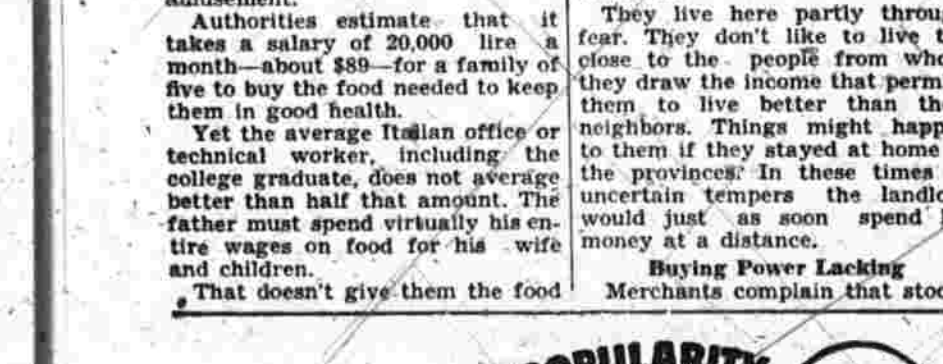
