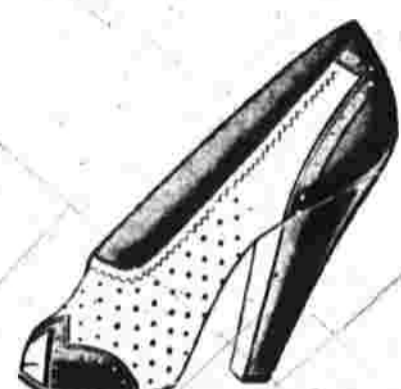

No Widespread Acceptance of Work Plea: Coal Strike Truce Goes into Final Hours

No Sign Miners Plan To Remain at Work Or Resume Walkout

Truman's Pledge to Restore Strike - Bound Railroads to Operation Adds New Note of Urgency to Impending Decision; Without Coal Many Trains Would Be Idle Again

Washington, May 25.—(AP)—Secretary of Interior Krug summoned John L. Lewis and his United Mine Workers' negotiating committee today a few hours before the soft coal strike truce was due to expire. The meeting, at 10:30 a. m. (e.s.t.), was the first with Lewis since the government outlined its position on the principal points at issue in Lewis' contract demands. Lewis' reaction was not made known in advance of today's meeting.

Washington, May 25.—(AP)—The coal strike truce went into its final hours today without a sign whether the miners will stick to their jobs or take up the 42-day walkout they interrupted two weeks ago. President Truman's pledge to restore the strained railroad operation added a new note of urgency to the impending decision, because without coal many of the trains soon would stand still again.

Point Hint of Hope One faint hint of hope in the coal picture—and it was no more than that—arose from the fact Mr. Truman did not couple his appeal to the striking rail workers with one to the miners. This could mean that the government, as has the settled plea, felt some assurance that the truce would be extended for further settlement talks. Unless extended, the final hour of the truce would be a very tense one.
