Agreement At Paris

Principally, we believe, because the Council of Foreign Ministers at Paris did not dare to commit itself to a final agreement which the big powers have been trying for so many months, it has now given the world a brand of agreement.

The big powers have accepted solutions of some of the big problems dividing themselves. They have considered such progress as to agree to the holding of a full 21-nation peace conference in Paris on July 29th.

What brand of agreement have the big powers produced in their progress so far?

It is an agreement which is far from any principle, particularly The Foreign Ministers did not take such a document as the Atlantic Charter and at down and try to find out what solution the principles stated there would dictate.

To the contrary, they met in an atmosphere of big power suspicion and power politics that they were a deadlock as long as they could stand it, proceeded to compromise these suspicions and rivalries.

The Atlantic Charter, the foreign territorial gain from this war; the Foreign Ministers took away from Italy its colonies without making any claim.

But although this agreement is formally in the name of peace, although an agreement which avoids all agreements in perhaps words, these decisions do not in themselves make any really constructive contribution to the general cause of peace.

The peace treaty, which is a very negative to be accepted in gratitude that they were not worse; and to be accepted with full realization that it would itself, they merely preserve the world's chance to work for something better.

The Foreign Ministers have agreed the peace treaty, but the infant still needs to get some better kind of flesh on its bones.

Missing An Opportunity? It is by restrained behavior that the present lapse of OPA controls they could convince the people of this country that their ambition is more business on a decent level, rather than every last cent of expected profit.

Perhaps a majority of the nation's producers and businessmen know this, and take their opportunity seriously. And perhaps, if they make the jump from OPA to a free economy without too much slack and do it now instead of six months or a year from now.

But such a program would be likely as the OPA-cessant roll by. There are those whose selfishness and greed will be the policy of responsibility. There are those who are not interested in a fair profit, but in all the profit they can possibly extract from the market.
