Has Trouble Over Sewage

Woolen Company In Hilliardville Reports Some Difficulties

The Ace Woolen Company, which owns the former Hilliard Woolen Mills in Hilliardville, is finding difficulty in preventing the sanitary sewer from emptying into the Bigelow Brook at the rear of the building and preventing it from flowing into the Stockman river.

To overcome the trouble from the mill the company has bought additional land from the Hilliard estate located to the south of the building and is using this land as a seepage plant.

They plan to have the sewage in the mill pumped up onto this land and allow the water to seep through the sand and to drain into the brook.

Reports to Health Board

The company has had attention from the local Board of Health concerning a sewer line from one or two of the houses on Adams street which now empties onto its property and into its recovery.

The Woolen company claims that there is no sewer rights over its property and to drain into the brook.

The Board of Health has been asked to assist in eliminating the trouble.

Unless this is done soon the woolen company has the right to block

up the sewer at the point where it enters its recovery and if this is done it is claimed that the sewage will then flow onto a public highway and cause a health menace.
