School Budget Set by Board
Final Figure is Fixed at \$601,000; Increase Over Last Estimate

The final figure arrived at the Joint School Board meeting last night for school costs in the year 1946-47 was \$601,000. This is an increase of nearly \$100,000 over the budget presented at the June 18 meeting.
