'Sweeping Victory' Seen With Baldwin

Mitchell Sees Success In November; Democrats Say Spurrings Only 'Double Talk'

Hartford, Aug. 17.—(AP)—Confident Republican leaders today saw Gov. Raymond E. Baldwin's decision to run for the U. S. Senate as ensuring a "sweeping victory" in the November election, while from the Democratic side came an assertion that the chief executive's decision was only "double talk."

With assured strength of Governor Baldwin spearheading the campaign, said Mitchell, "a sweeping 'Hire Hitler' campaign."

Democratic State Chairman John A. McGuire, fearing the governor a "hire Hitler" campaign, said the Baldwin announcement in a different light.

"This the governor was 'an adroitly making double talk' about running for office," McGuire charged. "He had the long time ago from the time he had been registered as a private citizen, the Connecticut insurance interests."

"Why should these interests," McGuire asked, "take a chance with Rep. Clarence H. Jones when they had served at his hand?"

Passage of the Insurance Act of 1946 has liberalized and broadened National Service Life Insurance into a flexible, peace-time contract suitable for the civilian needs of all veterans.

The Veterans who do not elect to reinstate their National Service Life Insurance will be irrevocably bound down the act of premium payment.
