Rotary Hears Rev. Timmins
Club Is Told of Program of Alcoholics Anonymous in Nation

The Rev. James F. Timmins, pastor of St. Bridget's church, and editor of the Catholic Transcript, was the guest speaker at the Manchester Rotary Club last evening. Father Timmins talked to the Rotarians about "Alcoholics Anonymous," whose work in developing a tremendous part in developing, both locally and nationally, he was introduced to the members by Dr. Bernard J. Sheridan, past president of the club.

The speaker stressed the fact that the "AA" program has an answer to each and every portion of the liquor problem, for it is concerned only with the person who is an alcoholic addict. It does not concern itself with the social or political aspects of this problem. Its members are not "reformers or prohibitionists," said Father Timmins. He went on to say that "alcohol is a gift to man," but the "liquor problem" arises from its abuse. The speaker also described the rising tide of "social pressure" in the use of alcohol in American communities. He said, drinking is the "thing to do." In Sweden on the other hand, social pressure exerts a negative force regarding the abuse of alcohol.

Father Timmins went on to describe the types of alcoholics not reached or reclaimed through Alcoholics Anonymous. These people, nevertheless, are successful in stopping their drinking. There are people who stop drinking because of their aversion; drinking has interfered with their desire for money or property; or because they are very unhappy. A person is ready for the program of Alcoholics Anonymous when he is unhappy because he is drinking, and not satisfied with his

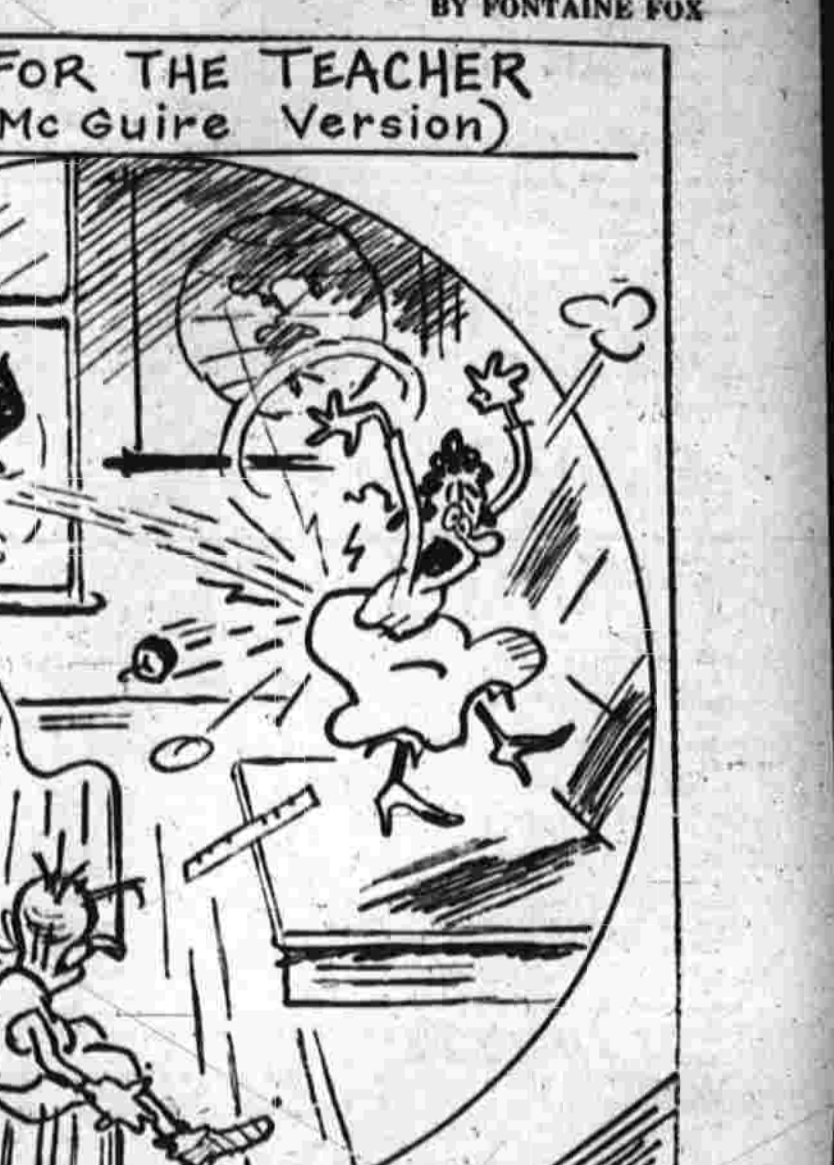
