Plan For Memorial Field
The Memorial Field Committee, created last winter to shoulder the responsibility for the town's development of the old golf links, has prepared its general development plan. This report, says the committee's forward, "is directed to the people of Manchester in the hope that they will find here a means whereby partial realization may be made of the 1,000 citizens who served their country when their help was sorely needed. Fully realizing that stately and architectural monuments furnish but mute testimony to sacrifices as great as have been recently performed, the townpeople last winter chose a Committee to direct their attention to the development of a Memorial Field which would live and breathe the spirit of youth.
