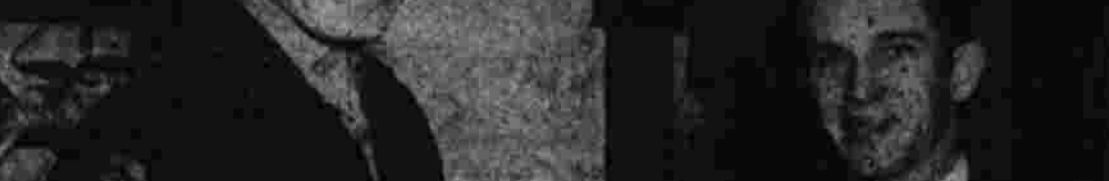

They dispose of territories without any formality of consideration of the wishes of the people living in these territories. They represent in short, one more piece of patchwork in that tangled mess which has been the result of a century of recorded history, being the status of Central Europe and the Balkans. As such, this present patchwork is perhaps less vicious and violent in nature than other previous settlements in which there has been less compromise and less consultation of the sentiments of the losers upon whom a peace settlement was being imposed. Still, it is not in itself a good thing.

Back In The Bottle
