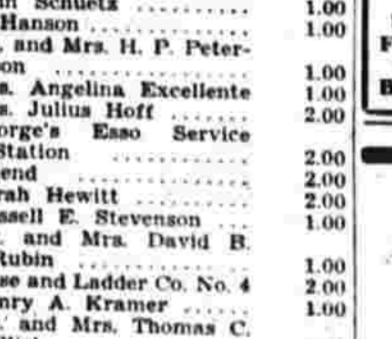

Douglas Faces Problem Now

Washington, Feb. 28.—(AP)—The problem of smoothing Anglo-American relations troubled by differences over Palestine emerged today as the first hurdle for presidential candidate Douglas when he takes over the embassy in London.

Douglas, whose prompt confirmation by the senate was assumed, submitted his resignation yesterday as president of the Mutual Life Insurance company of New York and told reporters he will hurry to England after a State Department briefing on his new task.

Terminating Britain's current economic crisis the result of "sanctions on all resources, human and otherwise, and the terrific suffering during the last war," Douglas said it must be remedied because of the "profound consequence to all the world."

The transatlantic controversy came to a head in a White House statement describing as "unfortunate and misleading" any British implication that President Truman was playing politics last Oct. 4 when he vetoed the immediate admission of 100,000 Jews to the Holy Land.

The statement handed out last night only a few hours after the president's return from London.

In the 52-year-old Douglas, President Truman picked a Democrat with a somewhat unorthodox political background.

Douglas was a congressman from Arizona when Franklin D.

Tax Already Figured On Short Form Table

DEDUCTIONS LIKE MEDICAL EXPENSES, CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS NOT LISTED BY USER

INCOME TAX ABCs FOR 1947

WHAT'S DEDUCTIBLE?

A. TAXES: State income, some property, federal income, state gasoline tax in about 40 states, some federal taxes incurred in carrying on a business.

B. INTEREST PAYMENTS: On personal loans, home mortgage, installment purchases.

C. CONTRIBUTIONS: To non-profit, charitable, religious, education or scientific groups. (Political contributions are not included.)

Deductions Automatic

You don't have to. Everyone using the short form automatically is allowed about a 10 per cent deduction. That's taken care of in the tax table.

If your deductions actually were more than 10 per cent of income, don't use the short form. You'll lose money. Use the long form.

With the long form you must itemize your deductible expenses but you can deduct up to \$3,000. If you have more than \$3,000 you can deduct separately or jointly on the long form.

Answer Questions In Order

Don't skip ahead on the short form. Start at the top, answering the questions as you go down.

Most people will need only one page. Some, with dependent children or annuities, also will use the top of Page 2.

How to do it:

You married, have two children. You had \$4,000 in salary last year and \$300 from dividends. You are \$37,000 from dividends. Your wife had no income.

You write your name, address, social security number. Then you list all exemptions: yourself, wife and two children, since they were dependent upon you.

Each exemption you can claim knocks \$500 off your total income before it becomes taxable.

Where it says "Your Income" you write your employer's name and address. List all other employers if you had more than one.

Turn To Tax Table

Then, under the \$4,000 salary and \$300 from dividends, add the tax. The total is \$4,000. Turn to the tax table on Page 4 to see what your tax is.

Because you're claiming four exemptions, look down the fourth column which shows that your tax on a man with four exemptions and \$4,000 total income is \$452. Write that on Page 1, Line 7.

But during the year the boss withheld from you \$100 salary tax and \$200 from dividends. A tax of \$300 in 1946 full tax was supposed to be withheld from all salaries and wages up to \$5,000.

So you write that \$300—the tax withheld from you—alongside (A) under Line 8, Page 1.

Due to Tax Withholding

You look at Line 7—the \$452 in total tax—and at Line 8—the \$300 tax withheld. The difference—\$152—is due to the tax on the \$200 in dividends from which no tax was withheld in 1946.

So you write that \$152—the difference between the tax withheld and the full tax owed—on Line 9.

Then you sign the return, tear Page 1 off the 4-page 1947 form, and turn it in to the collector of internal revenue by mail or in person.

In such a case, since you owe no money, you just file the return and the collector will refund to you the amount of money you've been over-taxed.

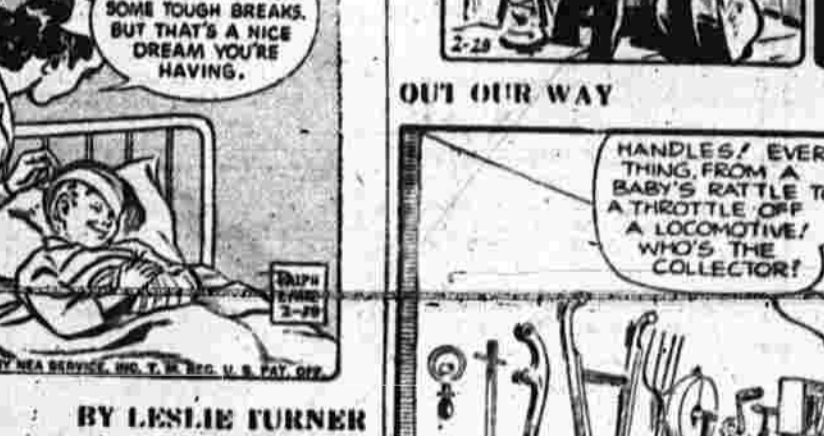
