Consider Substituting Income for Sales Tax

Switch Term 'Very Definite Possibility' As Chief Means of Financing Bonus

Hartford, March 15—High-ranking legislators today were seriously considering substituting a state income tax for Gov. James L. McConaughy's sales tax proposal as the chief means of financing the \$50,000,000 World War II veterans bonus now on the statute books.

The switch to an income impost was termed "a very definite possibility" last night by Senator Herbert B. Macdonald (R., North Haven), general assembly finance committee co-chairman, after Gov. McConaughy earlier had signed the bonus bill granting \$30 to \$200 payments to Connecticut veterans who served 90 or more days between Dec. 7, 1941 and Dec. 31, 1945.

To Challenge Constitutionality Although Rep. Charles E. Layman, Jr. (R., Middlefield), immediately announced he would challenge constitutionality of the bonus measure in the courts as soon as the governor had affixed his signature, Macdonald and his committee colleagues intend to set up the machinery to raise the necessary revenue before the bonus bill is passed.

Macdonald announced there is "a definite possibility" that a tax on dividends and interest and also for an income tax bill. He added that "despite what appears to be a widespread belief to the contrary, a general income tax is a very definite possibility as a substitute for the vigorously opposed sales tax."

However, no decision on any proposal for increased or new taxes will be made by the committee, Macdonald explained, until it has before it a complete and up-to-date picture of the state's actual financial needs. That will not be available, he asserted, until a special legislative economy study committee files its recommendations. This group has until March 28 to make its report.

All Bills Being Considered "In the meantime," Macdonald continued, "every revenue-raising bill that has been introduced is being given fair and careful consideration—including income tax measures as well as the sales tax."

Governor McConaughy repeatedly has declared that an income tax unless it reached down to the lowest brackets would not produce the \$200,000,000 which he and other administration leaders deem necessary to finance the bonus and other state educational aid.

Connecticut's chief executive consistently has advocated a sales tax, but last week at a press conference asserted he would not insist on it as a legislative "must."

"It has been declared unconstitutional before," Lyman told news men referring to a state Supreme court 1912 decision upholding plans for pensions for Civil War veterans, and a 1923 ruling by the late Attorney General Frank K. Constitution Not Engaged Yet An Army second lieutenant died during World War I. Lyman also said he was opposed to the bonus as a wasteful and unnecessary expense to the state funds. He asserted he has not engaged counsel as yet and therefore could not say when and where his action would be instituted against the bill.

Koski, who commented that the attorney general's office was being brought into the case, declared an action probably could be brought in Superior court during the present (March) term and referred to the State Supreme Court of Errors by agreement of the two parties. He declined to speculate how soon the State Supreme court might render a decision.

Ball Call Vote Passed

The measure was adopted on a roll call vote by a coalition of Republican insurgents and the Democratic majority after a moment had been defeated to submit the bonus issue to the voters. Amendment clarified the bonding provision of the bill and gave the state Finance Advisory committee, composed of the governor and other state officers, authority to control over expenses of the bonus administration. The Senate quickly approved both changes and passed the bill to Governor McConaughy.

Lyman, 52-year-old American Legion member, informed Assistant Attorney General Bernard A. Koski of his intention to bring court action challenging constitutionality of the bonus.

Lyman's move caught them by surprise. Sources close to the administration previously indicated they expected the legal challenge to come from other quarters other than from within the Legislature.

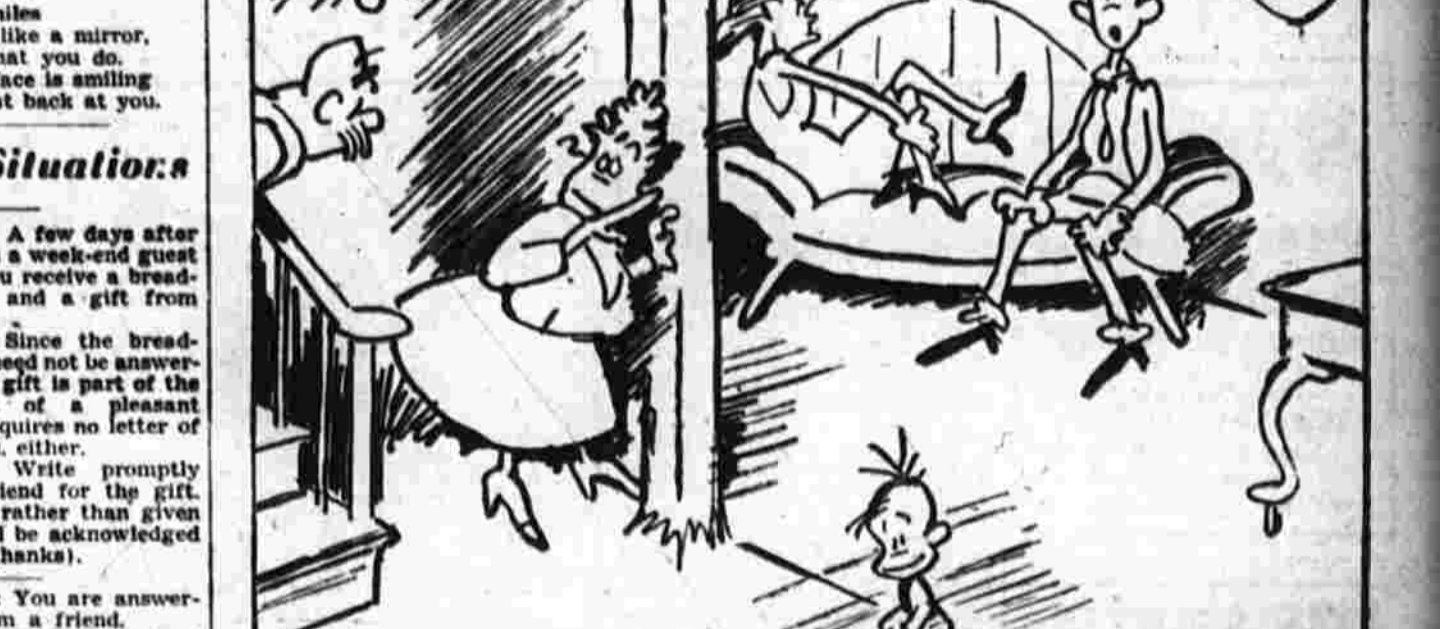
