### Local Officials Report Glaring Fire Hazards

There Are at Present Sixty Violations of Regulations in Buildings, Board Told

The Board of Selectmen, meeting last night, unanimously agreed that the town's fire marshals, perhaps in concert with state fire marshals, have a big job to do in Manchester.

There are at present some sixty glaring violations of fire safety regulations in buildings in town, the Board voted to refer the condition to the local fire inspection authorities to secure correction of hazardous conditions.

It was considered that the building inspector, who has been named as "permitting" the situation, is not responsible until inspection reports have been filed with the fire marshals.

**Fire Traps Exist**

Several of the conditions noted in a report handed to Selectmen last night have lasted for several years and in some cases, it was noted, "fire traps" exist. The violation was based on a report of 1945, but it was said that local conditions have changed only slightly since then. In spite of the fact that the building inspector does not have fire hazards inspection in existing structures as part of his duties, it was stated that Building Inspector David Chambers has nevertheless taken an active part in the furthering of safety measures and has acted to eliminate many dangers, properly within the scope of either local or state fire marshals.

**What Started Discussion**

Discussion of the Manchester fire conditions came as a result of an anonymous letter carried in the Herald in the Herald Along Main Street column, in which the writer condemned what were termed extremely dangerous fire hazards in this town.

Among the conditions which fire marshals will have drawn to their attention are doors in public buildings that open inward and in time of emergency might jam.

opinion that those concerned had better look into their duties and responsibilities at once and take immediate steps at correction before some catastrophe "lays the heavy hand of blame on their shoulders."

It was reported that a new law is in the course of passage, under which procedure to eliminate fire hazards is very clearly defined and in which the authority of the state to act is more clearly laid out.

In voting to refer conditions to the attention of the fire marshals, Board members said that they hoped for an early report from them on the results of their inspections.

### Board Dodges Ice Cream, Butter, Oysters Charity Recipients' Fare

Revealing that persons on town charity rolls are spending their food allowances on "ice cream, butter, oysters, expensive meats and other luxury items." Selectmen Sherwood G. Bowers told the Board of Selectmen last night that he thought some control should be established over this situation in the interest of the taxpayers and the relief recipients themselves.

Stating that he had examined several relief food bills on which such items appear, Bowers said that he has no mind to begrudge the necessities of life to those on town aid, but that luxuries are another matter.

He said that he noticed that very little margarine was used, but that "in my own family, when we have to buy such things, we can't afford butter, and if I can use margarine, so can relief people." Other Selectmen concurred.

Town Treasurer George H. Wadell said he had noticed the growing tendency to buy expensive food items, and he suggested a return to the former practice whereby the town drew up a list of staples, and relief recipients were held to such purchases.

The question of awarding rents that is expected to be a rather difficult and time-consuming matter, considering the numbers of applicants.

### Bantly Asks Building Line He Wants to Find Out Extent of His Property At The Green

A request that the building line and street line be made to coincide with the old Woodbridge tavern property on East Center street at the Green was made of the Board of Selectmen last night by the owner of the lot, Ernest Bantly. Mr. Bantly was represented by Attorney Raymond A. Johnson, and both spoke in favor of the request.

Johnson noted that some time ago his client had begun an establishing a gasoline station on the lot which is zoned for business, but had later let this matter rest. Then, it was said, he had a chance to sell the property, but the deal

did not take place because the prospective buyer discovered a 40-foot building line on the lot—a condition of which Mr. Bantly was not aware. He said the lot depth is only 135 feet, and the cutting off of 40 feet in front seriously lessened the value of the lot.

Mr. Bantly also noted that he has other troubles with this property, and he wants to "find out how much he really has got there." He stated that W. Harry England, who owns adjoining property, has been crossing the rear of the Bantly lot to get to the England home, and that England now claims he has established a right of way over Bantly's land. In addition, Bantly said, he perceived

that a nearby resident to "edge over" a little in setting up a fence, and this may become complicated as well. Bantly noted that in other nearby business structures, the building line is the street line, and that he requested a public hearing be held so that action can be taken to give his property this same advantage. The hearing is set for June 3, 8 p. m. in the municipal building. After the hearing, the selection will make their decision.
