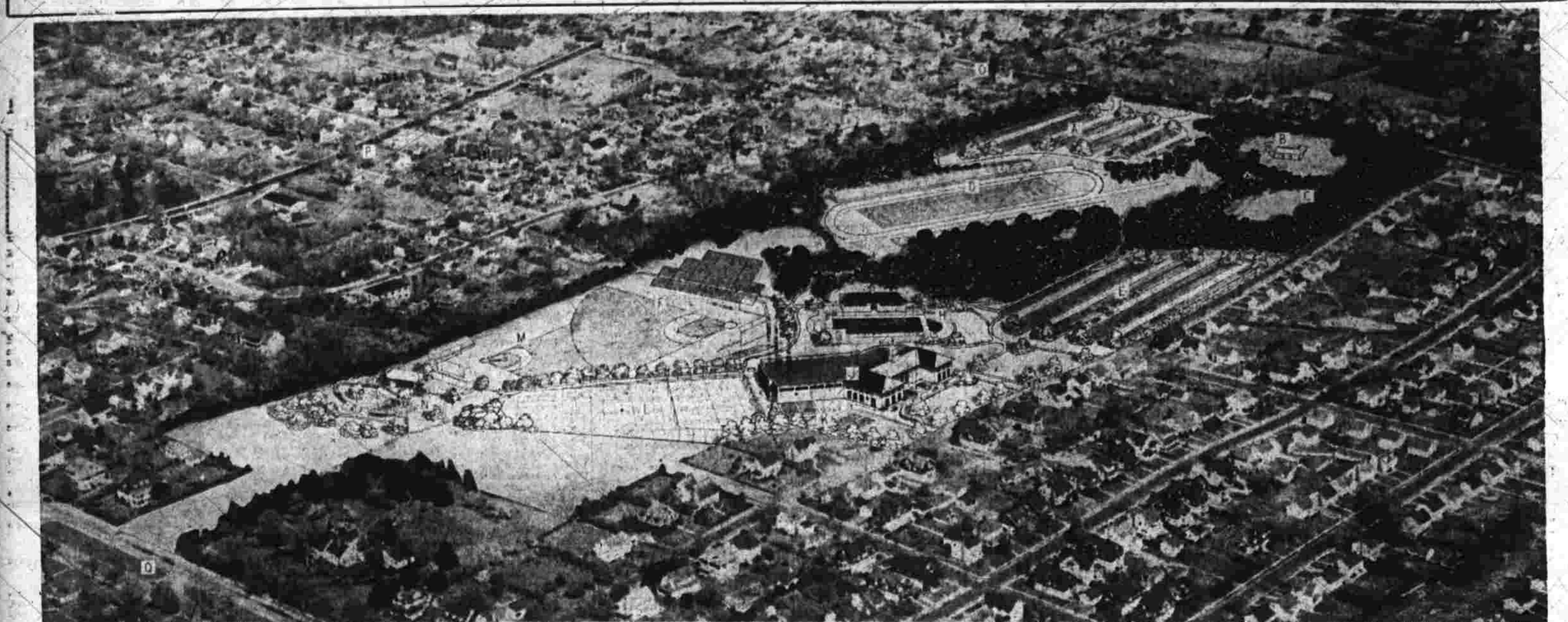

# Here Is Air View Sketch of Proposed Memorial Field



Above is reproduced the sketch of the proposed development of Memorial Field, shown from an aerial photograph of the section surrounding the Old Golf Links between East Center street and Middle Street, east. The sketch was prepared by James H. May and Associates, Architects and Site Planners. At Monday night's special town meeting in High School assembly hall the voters will be asked to appropriate the sum of \$200,000 to begin work on the development of Memorial Field.

The sketch is intended to provide under this appropriation, the following: (A)—To provide parking areas, picnic grounds, children's playgrounds, football, baseball and track areas, horseshoe courts and sufficient grounds for all of the ground work to be started under this plan, actual construction of proposed buildings being deferred for the present.

The map shows the 41 acre tract having purchased the natural park and playground area for a memorial to veterans of World War I. New the voters are being asked to appropriate the funds to develop the land for playground and park purposes. When completed the area would be housed with recreation buildings for leisure sports, a swimming pool, seating arrangements for the various athletic fields and an outdoor theater.

Legend for the above sketch is as follows: A—Parking area; B—Picnic pavilion; C—Track grounds and children's playground; D—Football, baseball and quarter-mile track; E—Swimming pool; F—Baseball field and bleachers; G—Swimming pool and bathhouse; H—Children's wading pool; I—Recreation building; K—Handball courts; L—Tennis courts; M—Horseshoe courts; N—Tennis courts; O—Volley ball, badminton, shuffleboard, dancing, ice skating; P—Football field and bleachers; Q—Outdoor theater; R—High School; S—Sunmit street intersection; T—Main street; Q—East Center street.
